Old news: We already know by now that <u>any</u> of PulseTech's multi-station chargers can charge multiple different types of batteries simultaneously, right?

New news: We have a brand-new member of the PulseTech family; the Bench Top 6 station charger. Designed for the shops that want the capability and advanced technology of the Pallet or BenchTop 12 station chargers, but in a smaller package.

Common Features for all multi-station chargers, including the new Bench Top 6:

- One switch operation (on/off with easy to read LED indicators indicating battery status.
- Smart technology; Auto Diagnose, Recover, Charge and Maintain.
- Patented, High Frequency Pulse Technology removes sulfate crystals.
- Works on all 12V (24V for Dual 24) lead acid battery types; VRLA, AGM, flooded and gel.
- Universal power input; 100 to 250Vac operation anywhere in the world.
- Reverse polarity protected, ruggedized military casings, and Replaceable charging cards, cables and more (with NSNs) on the Pallet, Bench Top 12 & 6 station chargers.
- All have independent charging channels operating in isolation from one another;
 - > Simultaneously charge any combination of batteries (VRLA / AGM, Gel or flooded cell)
 - > Fully automated systems which diagnose the condition of each individual battery and automatically provides the appropriate charge for maximum battery



Are you stationed someplace that gets a good amount of sunlight? If so, you may want to look at adding solar capability to your BMMP. The 2 examples below are the most widely used 24V systems. These systems both produce 6.3 Watts, have High Frequency Pulsation, are extremely rugged, and very easy to install.



The 24 V Pulse Solar Charger NSN 6130-01-487-0035 at left is hard wired on the platform and comes with a complete mounting kit.

The 24V Solar Pulse Charge Monitor System NSN 613-01-558-5371 at right plugs into the slave receptacle and is secured to the vehicle via a supplied Velcro strap.
