
Horse Breeds!

ACROSS


- 1. Leopard, blanket, spots, and snowflake are a few words used to describe this breed.

- **10.** An elegant, high stepping breed primarily used in harness events.
- **11.** The top speed of this breed has been recorded at 88.5 km/ hour, but only for a short distance.
- **12**. This breed is small and sturdy and are always chestnut with a flaxen mane and tail.
- 13. This pony breed was originally bred on an island in Canada.
- 14. A warmblood breed originally bred to pull carriages.
- **16.** The breed of pony is broken down into 4 distinct sections.
- 17. Originating from Spain, this breed is strongly built, compact and elegant with a thick mane or tail.

- **2.** A distinctive head shape and tail carriage sets this breed apart.
- **3.** This breed originated in Scotland, and famously stars in Budweiser commercials.
- 4. A wild horse breed, originally descended from Spanish horses.
- 6. One of the earliest horse breeds developed in the United States.
- 7. A gaited breed, often referred to as the "Horse America Made"
- **9.** A "hot-blooded" breed known for their speed, agility and heart.
- 15. The oldest registered warmblood breed.
- 18. Originally from Scotland, thousands of these ponies worked in mines during the Industrial Revolution in Great Britain.









6. In 2015, became the first horse to win the Grand Slam of Thoroughbred racing, winning the Triple Crown and the Breeders' Cup Classic.

8. An American hero during the Great Depression, this little racehorse beat the 1937 Triple Crown winner, War Admiral, in a special 2 horse race.

11. In 1973, he became the first Triple Crown Winner in 25 years, finishing with a record-breaking victory in the Belmont Stakes in which he won by 31 lengths.

12. Purchased for \$80, he was originally a plough horse who went on to become a world-famous show jumper

14. A buckskin mustang, known as the Stallion of the Cimarron.

16. The sorrel filly in the classic movie, My Friend Flicka.

17. The Lone Ranger's white stallion.

18. A flying white horse from Greek mythology.

19. Ridden by John Whitaker, he was the first show jumper to win more than 1 million dollars in prize money.

21. The main character in a classic children's story by Anna Sewell about a horse that narrates his own life story.

2. 2010's Best Horse in the World, won a Gold and Silver medal with Eric Lamaze at the Olympic Games in Beijing in 2008.
3. The highest scoring dressage horse in history, winner of 2 Olympic gold medals at the London Games in 2012, and a gold and silver medal in Brazil in 2016.

4. Considered one of the greatest racehorses of all time although his racing career occurred 100 years ago, he appears in almost all modern American Thoroughbred pedigrees.
5. A character in the animated movie. Tangled.

7. A Canadian thoroughbred who won the Kentucky Derby and Preakness Stakes in 1964. One of only two horses in the Canadian Sports Hall of Fame

9. The star of a TV show about a talking Palomino.


10. Winning a silver medal at the 1968 Olympic Games in Mexico, he remains the only pony to have ever competed in showjumping at the Olympics.

13. This longtime teammate of Ian Millar is a Canadian Icon.
Honored with his own postage stamp in 1999, this tall chestnut is one of only two horses in the Canadian Sports Hall of Fame.
15. This piebald ran the Grand National in the book National Velvet.
20. The first horse to score above 90 in dressore competition.
