ENTRY FEE

The submission fee is nonrefundable \$25 (US) for up to three entries.

HOW TO ENTER

All submissions must be submitted in person during the specified submission dates/hours to Crossroads Art Center at 2016 Staples Mill Road, Richmond, Virginia 23230.

Completed entry forms, along with the \$25 entry fee, are required to complete submission. The entry fee can be paid beforehand online <u>CLICK HERE</u> or at time of submission.

SALES

All work must be for sale. Artists will receive 85% of sales price. Crossroads Art Center will receive 5% and the Richmond Greek Festival will receive 10%.

LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT

Crossroads Art Center LLC will accept only original 2D and 3D artwork handcrafted by the artist, excluding jewelry. The gallery reserves the right to refuse delivered work if it differs from the submitted image, if the frame is in poor condition, or if the work is not properly wired. Signing the entry form or submitting entries online denotes agreement to the terms and conditions as stated in the entry information. The gallery is not responsible for items that are lost, stolen, or damaged while on display at the art center.

DISPLAY INFORMATION

All hanging work must be wired for hanging with professional-grade wire. Screw eyes are accepted, but D-rings are preferred. Pieces with saw-tooth hangers will not be accepted. Ensure corners of frames, whether metal or wood, are tightly joined and have no scuffs, scrapes, or chips.
