






Operating The Pump

Press the pressure unit toggle button Press the pressure increase button or decrease button to set the required pressure value you need. The pressure value can range from 0 to 20PSI.



After finishing the above steps, press the On/Off button & to start to inflate.



Switching To Deflate

Remove the hose from the inflation inlet, Connect the pump hose fixing to the deflation outlet on the pump, and twist clockwise to tighten it, as **Figure 1.**Connect the nozzle end of the hose to in inflatable.

Press the On/Off button on the pump to start the deflation function until all the gas is removed, then press the On/Off button to stop the deflation.
