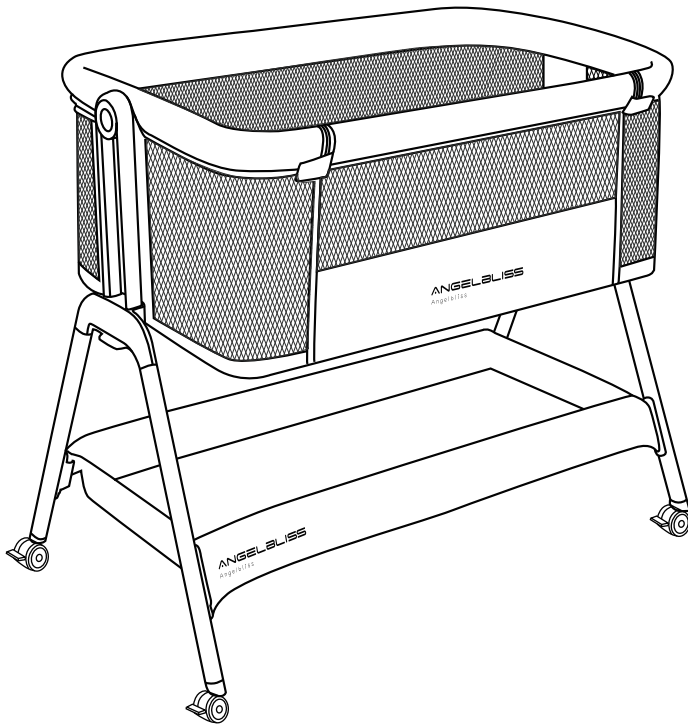


Bedside Crib Manual



IMPORTANT! READ CAREFULLY
AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE



WARNING

Failure to follow these warnings and the instructions could result in serious injury or death.

Read all instructions before assembling and using the product.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD **Babies Have Suffocated:**

- On pillows, comforters, and extra padding.
- In gaps between a wrong-size mattress, or extra padding and product sides.
- **NEVER** add soft bedding or padding.
- **Use** ONLY the mattress/pad provided by Manufacture.
- **NEVER** add a pillow, comforter or another mattress for padding.
- **Always** place baby on back to sleep to reduce the risk of SIDS and suffocation.
- **If** a sheet is used with the pad, use only the one provided by the product manufacturer or one specifically designed to fit the dimension of the product mattress.

FALL HAZARD: —To help prevent falls,

- Do not use this product when infant begins to push upon hands and knees, can roll over or reached 19.84lbs(9kg), whichever comes first.
- Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a product or attach strings to toys.
- Do not use if any part of the bassinet/bedside sleeper is broken, torn, or missing

Read all instructions before assembling and using the product.

WARNING

Assembly instructions that include: chassis & mattress.

WARNING

Correct assembly of product.

WARNING

Correct assembly and use of the attachment system, including graphics.

WARNING

Correct conversion (when applicable) from one use mode to another.

WARNING

Keep instructions for future use.

WARNING

Always read and follow assembly instructions for each product use mode (bedside sleeper, bassinet).

WARNING

Assemble product according to manufacturer's instruction for ANY use mode—bedside sleeper as well as the bassinet or bedside sleeper modes, or both.

WARNING

This bedside sleeper is designed for use only with adult beds that between 23 and 27 inches from floor to top of adult mattress.

WARNING

A bedside sleeper is designed to provide a sleeping area for an infant until he or she begins to push up on hands and knees or approximately 5 months of age. Move your child to another sleeping product when your child reaches this stage.



WARNING

⚠️ WARNING

Entrapment Hazard—To prevent death from entrapment, bedside sleeper must be properly secured to adult bed using the attachment system.

(1) There must be no more than 1/2 in. (13 mm) gap between bedside sleeper and adult bed.

(2) Check tightness before each use by pulling bedside sleeper in a direction away from adult bed.

(3) If gap exceeds 1/2 in. (13 mm), DO NOT use product. Do not fill the gap with pillows, blankets or other items that are suffocation hazards.

⚠️ WARNING

Always use ALL required parts for each use mode. Check instruction manual for a list of required parts. Periodically check product for loose, damaged, or missing parts.

⚠️ WARNING

Read all instructions before assembling and using the product .

⚠️ WARNING

Check this bassinet regularly before using it, and do not use it if any part is loose or missing or if there are any signs of damage. Do not substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer if replacement parts or additional instructions are needed.

⚠️ WARNING

Always check that the bassinet is securely locked on the base/stand by pulling upwards on the bassinet bed.

⚠️ WARNING

Do not use this bassinet if you cannot exactly follow the instructions that come with it.

⚠️ WARNING

Do not place this bassinet near a window or patio door where a child could reach the cord of a blind or curtain and be strangled.

⚠️ WARNING

Use only the one provided by the bassinet or cradle manufacturer or one specifically designed to fit the dimension of the bassinet or cradle mattress.

WARNING

To avoid death from the infant's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adult bed the top rail must be no higher than the adult bed mattress.

WARNING

The attachment system must ALWAYS be used in bedside sleeper mode. See instruction manual product base or attachment system for further instructions.

WARNING

Strings can cause strangulation ! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a bassinet or cradle or attach strings to toys.

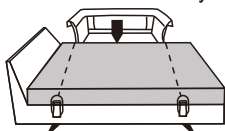

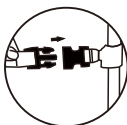
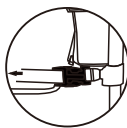
- The type adult beds (BELOW fig) with which the bed side sleeper **CAN OR CAN NOT BE USED.**

⚠ WARNING

The attachment system **must ALWAYS** be used in bedside sleeper mode

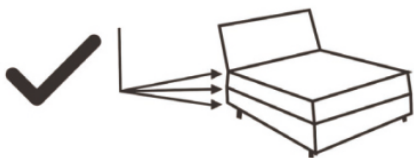


Align the crib directly next to the parent bed and pass the Attachment System underneath the mattress of the bed and around the bed frame

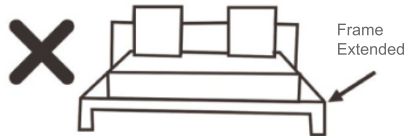


Secure the Attachment System by connecting the clip buckles together. Pull strap to tighten the Attachment System securely to the bed

Mattress , Box springs & Frame aligned

UNACCEPTABLE ADULT BED CONDITIONS FOR CO SLEEPING MODE (BED FRAME NOT IN-LINE)

Not suitable for use next to water beds or children's beds.

- Let the bedside crib toward to adult's bed.
- Connect the bedside crib and adult's bed with strap, the strap have to place between mattress and frame of adult's bed.

⚠ WARNING

- When using the bedside bed function, the drop side rail that must be removed and kept well.

⚠ WARNING

- When fixing the bedside bed, the short guardrail edge must be closely fitted with the adult mattress to avoid any gap.
- The bedside sleeper can be used for aligned adult bed only.

Meanwhile the distance from the lowest bottom side of the aligned adult bed(the drop side) to the ground should be more than 20cm.

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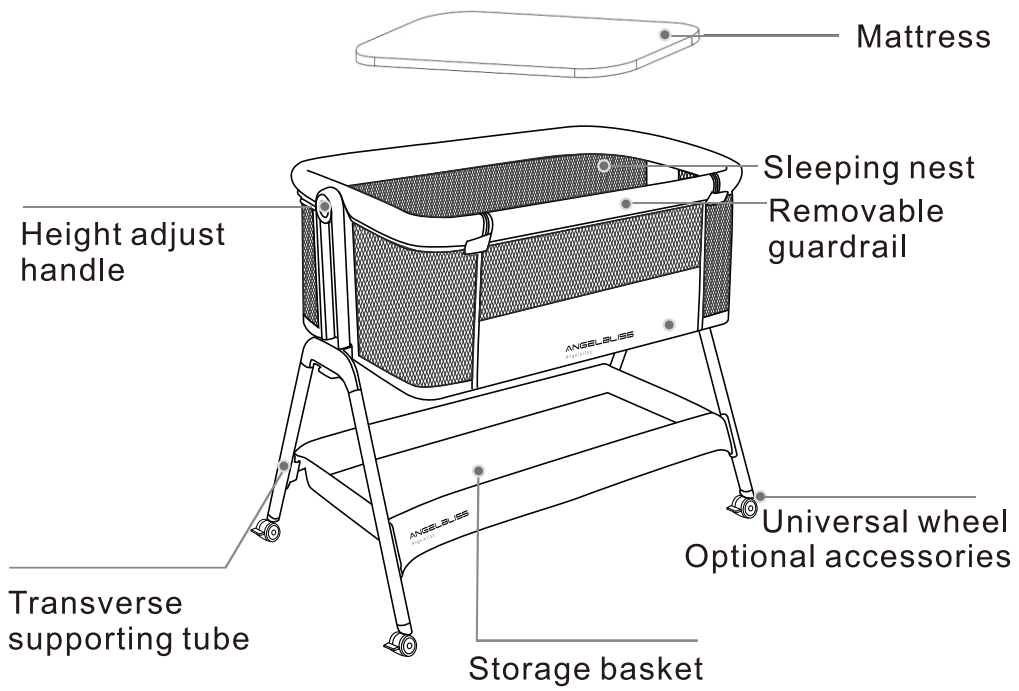
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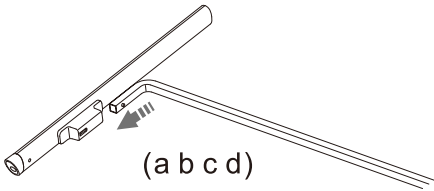
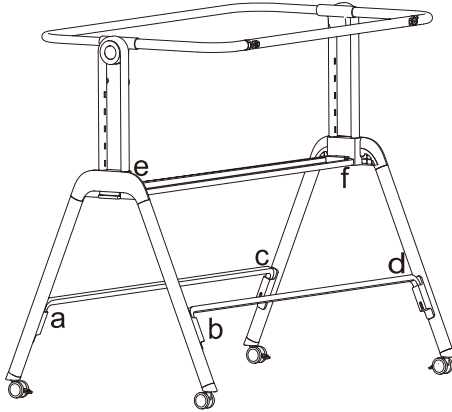
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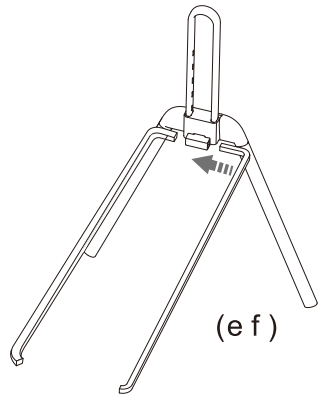
Parts list



How to assembly the brackets

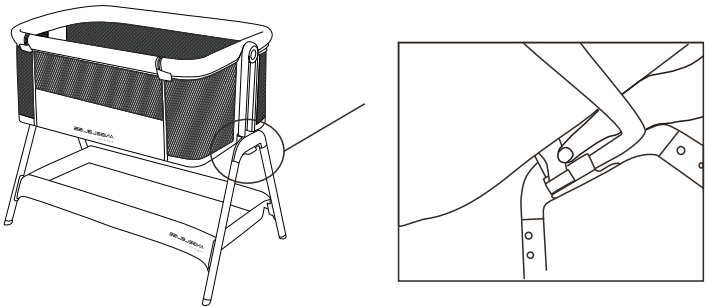


Insert the transverse supporting tube into the plastic joint until you hear a clicking sound

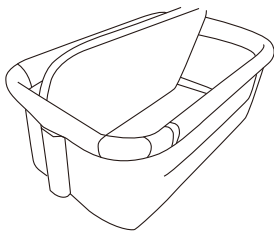


Insert the Bracket tube into the plastic joint until you hear a clicking sound

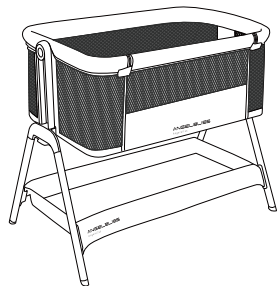
How to assembly the sleeping nest



Fixed velcro through plastic hole

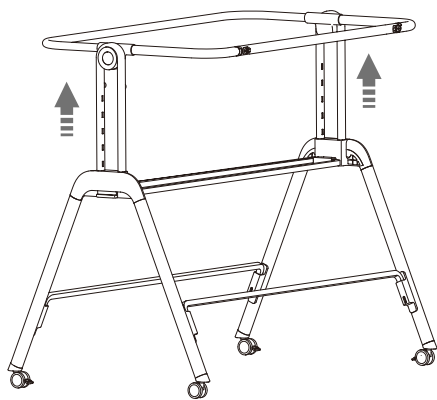


Place the mattress then keep it flat

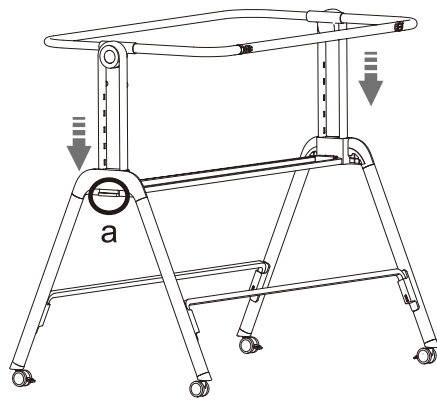


The crib is fully installed.

Height Adjustment

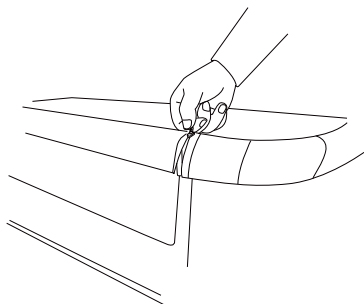


Lip up the plastic height adjust handle both sides, then it comes higher.

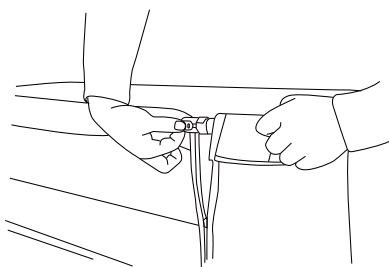


Lip up the plastic height adjust handle both sides, then pull down the nest, it comes lower as you need.

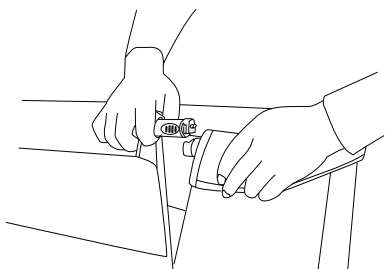
How to remove the guardrail



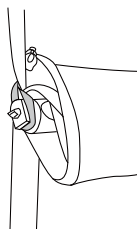
Unzip the zipper both sides of guardrail



Push the button as indicated by the arrow on the button



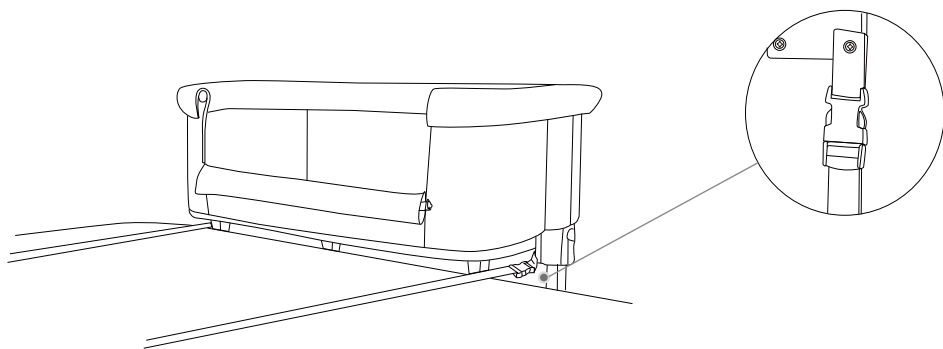
Remove the ends of the guardrail



Then roll up the guardrail tube and fix it by elastic cord.
Now it is ready for use.

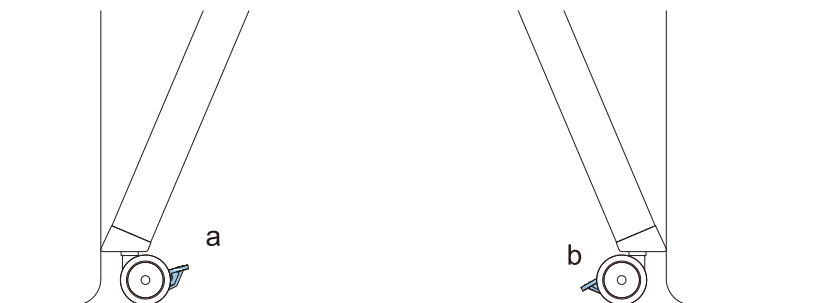
“DANGER!-Always completely raise the drop side when not attached to the adult’s bed”.

How to use as bedside sleepers



Put the webbing go through the bed mattress then buckle up buckles.

“DO NOT use bedside sleeper if any parts are missing, damaged, or broken. Contact us for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts”.

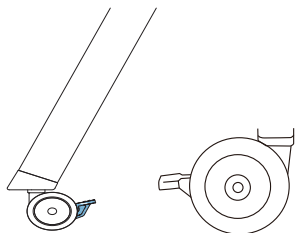


Make sure the crib foot reach the adult's bed sideboard as shown in picture 'a' .

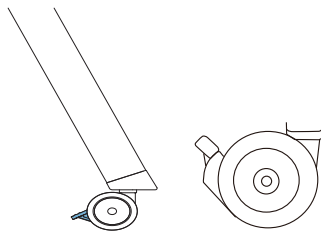
Then step down and lock the wheels as shown in picture 'b' .
