

Instructions for Hooligan Windscreen SKU# 0700-1023



Step 1:Remove screw with a #2 Phillips screwdriver.
Repeat on the other side




Step 2:Remove screw with a #2 Phillips screwdriver.
Repeat on the other side




Step 3:Carefully release clip with a long flat screwdriver.
Repeat on the other side




Step 4: Carefully remove headset cover



Step 5:Locate both indented dots on the inside of headset cover



Step 6:Drill pilot holes through both indents from the inside of the headset cover



Step 7: With a 5/8 drill bit carefully line up on the pilot holes and drill both holes from the outside



Step 8:

(painted side)

Temporarily clip headset cover back in place. Locate the 2 large Allen bolts and black collars (supplied in hardware) Install these pieces and check for proper clearance. It may be necessary to remove a small amount of material to get the proper clearance and alignment. This can be done with a Dremmel type tool.







Step 9:

Open hardware packages and create 4 separate groups of parts as shown.

Begin assembling windshield mounts as illustrated







Step 10: Install hardware on windshield and align strut mount holes



Step 11:Loosen Allen set screws on mounts and slide struts through mounts



Step 12:The windshield height is adjustable.
This is measurement we used for or our install.
The height can be set to your preference



Step 13:

Reinstall the 4 mounting screws on headset cover and make sure the clips are secure.

Next install the mounting clips on the Allen bolts.



Step 14:

- -Install nut and lock washer on both sides of the lower strut.
- -Slide both struts throw the mounts on the lower headset.
- -Install the lock washer and nut(hand tight) on both sides.
- -Tighten the Allen bolts on both sides closing the clamp
- -Tighten the nuts on both



Step 15:

This is how the installed windshield should look Double check all the set screws, bolts and nuts making sure they are all tight.
