
Instructions for Mounting Front Crash Bars (FCC1)

Items you will need:

- 1. Roll of 3/4" masking tape
- 2. Electric drill
- 3. 1/4" drill bit
- 4. 5/16" drill bit
- 5. Set of metric wrenches

Instructions for mounting on a P200E or P125X:

- Place a piece of the ¾" masking tape along the top edge of the turn signal assembly and another piece along the inside edge (see figure to right).
- 2. Mark a spot in the middle of the vertical piece of tape where it crosses the horizontal piece of tape on both sides
- 3. Drill a 5/16" hole through the tape at the spot you marked (The tape will help protect the paint from chipping)
- 4. Attach the 'L' brackets to the bottom of the crash bars.
- 5. Mount the 2 front bolts to the crash bars from inside the glove box. (Do not tighten them yet)
- 6. Line up the 'L' brackets underneath the scooter and mark the spots to drill the holes.
- 7. Drill 4 1/4" holes in the spots you marked.
- 8. Attach the bottom 'L' brackets with the hardware provided.
- 9. Remove the crash bars and insert the center retaining piece.
- 10. Reinstall the crash bars and tighten all the bolts.
