
# How to Install






#### **For Outside Mount**


#### **Mounting the Brackets**

- 1. Brackets (B) will be mounted to the wall above the window.
- 2. Use a measuring tape to measure and mark the exact width of the shade.
- 3. Hold brackets (B) 2" inside from markings. Use a pencil to mark the exact location of each screw.
- 4. Brackets (B) must be mounted perfectly horizontal, so use a level to ensure markings are level. (If using a 3rd bracket, place the bracket in the exact center of outside marks)
- 5. Use a 1/16" drill bit to slowly drill a hole for each screw location.
- 6. Screw the brackets (B) into place. To ensure a secure mount, use wall anchors (provided).
- 7. Continue to "Installing the Shade."











#### For Inside Mount


#### **Mounting the Brackets**

- 1. Brackets (B) will be installed on the roof of your window frame.
- 2. Hold the brackets (B) 2" from edge of window frame. Make sure brackets are positioned so there is no interference with cords and mechanisms inside the headrail (A).
- 3. Mark the exact location of each screw with a pencil.
- 4. Use a level to ensure markings are aligned and level across the width of the window. (If using a 3rd bracket (B), place the bracket in the exact center of other brackets.)
- 5. Use a 1/16" drill bit to slowly drill a hole for each screw location.
- 6. Screw brackets (B) into place. To ensure a secure mount, wall anchors (provided) may be needed.
- 7. Continue to "Installing the Shade."










# **Installing the Shade**

(Same for Outside and Inside Mount)

- 1. Lift the headrail (A) of shade up to bracket (B).
- 2. Rest the headrail's (A) groove onto front lip of bracket (B).
- 3. Push the headrail (A) back until it catches onto the back of the bracket (B). You'll hear an audible "click" when the headrail is securely in place.



### **Removing the Shade**


(Same for Outside and Inside Mount)

- 1. To remove, insert a screwdriver into the hole on the bracket's bottom tab.
- 2. Push tab back to release headrail.




# **Attaching the Handle**

- 1. Attach the handle (C) to the center of the bottom rail of the shade (A).
- 2. Check carefully to assure the handle is properly snapped into place.



## **Operating the Shade**

- 1. To raise your shade, simply pull the handle up to the desired location.
- 2. Pull handle down to lower shade.



#### **Cleaning and Maintanence**

The vinyl headrail and bottom rail can be wiped clean with a damp sponge. To clean the shade fabric, use a feather duster or vacuum lightly using the soft brush attachment.
