





WELCOME TO CHORLEY FC MATCHDAY PROGRAMME

Exciting Changes to Enhance Your Matchday Experience! We are thrilled to announce that, as part of our new ownership's commitment to improving and modernising the matchday experience, we have made some significant changes for the 2023/24 season. These changes coincide with the implementation of our new integrated ticketing system, which will go live for our first game of the season!

Online Tickets

In a change from previous seasons, we are now offering discounted ticket prices to everyone who purchases their tickets online for matches at the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium. To secure the best price on single match tickets, simply visit our new ticket site and purchase your tickets. Online ticket sales will be available until shortly before kick-off (online ticket sales will close 2 hours prior). Then, on matchday, all you need to do is show up at the turnstiles, have your e-ticket scanned on your phone, and you're in! It's that simple.

In-person Tickets

We will continue to offer on-the-day in-person ticket sales for the 2023/24 season. However, the price of these tickets will be slightly higher compared to our online option. Please note that payment at the turnstiles will no longer be available. Instead, on-the-day in-person ticket purchases will be facilitated through our new ticket booth at the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium. The ticket booth will accept both cash and card payments. Once you've obtained your ticket, you can proceed to the turnstiles as usual for ticket scanning and entry.

WELCOME TO CHORLEY FC MATCHDAY PROGRAMME

In addition to the ticket purchasing changes, we have revised our admission categories for the first time since 2019. To address instances where individuals deliberately attempted to purchase tickets incorrectly to gain access to cheaper admission prices, we have simplified the process to ensure fairness for all supporters. From now on, anyone aged 18 to 64 will be classified as an adult and will be required to purchase an adult admission ticket.

WEVE MET BEFORE...BACK WHEN THEY WERE CALLED SPENNYMOOR UNITED....

Saturday 16th November 1996, Chorley 1-0 Spennymoor Unted

The aviation industry had one of its darkest months on record in November 1996 with the loss of over six hundred passengers in three separate incidents.

On November 8, a Boeing 727 crashed into the Atlantic Ocean immediately after take-off from Lagos airport. Four days later, a Saudi Airlines 747 collided in mid-air with a Kazakhstan Airlines II-76 in New Delhi. On November 23, hijacked Ethiopian Airlines Flight 961 crashlanded in the Indian Ocean after running out of fuel.

Chorley had not won a competitive game of football since beating Runcorn 4-0 at Victory Park on October 8 – a span of nine matches – and they had won only six league fixture all season. In late spring, manager Dave Sutton had led the Magpies to the semi-final of the FA Trophy, but by late October he was gone, having resigned from the role citing business and family reasons.

Welcoming Spennymoor who sat five places below the Magpies in the table, there was a good reason to be optimistic, however Chorley had not beaten the side from the North East since Paul Moss gave Chorley the victory in an FA Trophy replay back in December 1990, a span of five fixtures.

Finally, though, the long awaited for victory came. In front of 300 spectators Karl Marginson got the only goal of a scrappy game midway through the first half.



Saturday 29th August 1998, Chorley 2-2 Spennymoor United


A fifteenth-place finish at the end of the 1997-98 season was yet another disappointment for the Magpies in the Northern Premier League. In fact, there had been precious little to remember in the nineties when tenth in the 1993-94 season represented the high water mark of the decade.

As the anticipation for the new season began to build, the world was rocked by three horrific bombings. First, on August 7 1998, the US embassies in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania, and Nairobi, Kenya, were targeted, killing 224 people. Secondly, the Omagh bombing on August 15 in Northern Ireland led to the deaths of 29 people, and is widely known as signalling the end of the Troubles when a ceasefire by the IRA was called shortly after.

Chorley kicked off the new campaign a week later on August 22 away at Gateshead and recorded a creditable goalless draw. The season really got started forty-eight hours later as the Magpies put Accrington Stanley to the sword 4-0 thanks to a brace from Matt Swailes, an own goal, and one from Colin Potts.

For those waking up to breakfast television on Saturday August 29, 1998, SMTV Live and CD:UK, hosted back-to-back by Ant and Dec with Cat Deeley, had their official debuts. Later that afternoon Chorley welcomed Spennymoor United to Lancashire and were caught sleeping by the visitors – without a point from their first two games – who scored one of the fast goals seen at Victory Park thanks to Stephen Preen. On the half hour mark Spennymoor then extended their lead further thanks to Alu Bangura.

After a word from manager Bryan Griffiths at half time though, Chorley came out a different proposition in the second half and a brace from Andy Grimshaw ensured Chorley's unbeaten start to the season was safe.

CHORLEY secured a well-deserved win on their travels away at Spennymoor Town on Boxing Day, beating the Moors 0-2 - cementing their third-place position in the Vanarama National League table in the process.

The Magpies almost went a goal behind early on though, Keenan Ferguson striking his cross unintentionally off the crossbar but it fortunately bounced out and away from Matt Urwin in goal.

With 16 minutes on the clock Andy Preece's side hit the front, **MIKE CALVELEY** slamming home his sixth goal of the season past James Montgomery.

The Moors were handed a golden chance to get back on terms minutes late though, Jack Moore adjudged to have fouled Reece Staunton - Taylor couldn't take advantage from the spot, down to Urwin's heroics in saving his penalty.

Urwin continued to keep Chorley in the game in the opening 45 minutes, standing tall to keep out Rob Ramshaw's shot at point blank range.

Spennymoor continued to ramp up the pressure after the restart, Urwin called upon once more to again keep out Ramshaw - this time with his head.

Chorley would kill the stem of the hosts' momentum minutes later though, **CARLTON UBAEZUONU** capitalising on a defensive error to then round Montgomery and fire into an empty net to make it 0-2.

The Moors, to their credit, continued to push for a way back into the game but struggled to create anything of note in the second-half and it was Chorley who went closer to bagging a third - Jack Hazlehurst having his shot cleared off the line by the head of Michael Ledger.

CHORLEY secured a deserved sixth consecutive home win on Saturday afternoon, beating Curzon Ashton 4-0 to stay third in the Vanarama National League North table for Christmas.

The Magpies started the game quickly and were rewarded for their early efforts, albeit fortuitously - Jordan Richards putting the ball into the back of his own net with sixminutes on the clock.

Andy Preece's side continued to be relentless in their press and that proved to be the undoing of The Nash - Johnson nipping in to win the ball in the final-third before a burst of pace towards goal, to then find **MARCO RUS** who took his chance confidently, slotting the ball perfectly into the bottom corner past Josh Ollerenshaw.


The first-half came to a close with little to note after Chorley's second goal but game came back to life quickly after the break, Carlton Ubaezuonu excellently winning a penalty from Marcus Poscha's lazy challenge, the former then stepped up to take the spot-kick but Ollerenshaw saved it, only to see the rebound smashed home by **JOHNSON.**

Chorley then went on to add a fourth before full-time, Ubaezuonu flicking it to David Moyo who took it towards goal brilliantly before teeing up **JACK HAZLEHURST** who finished cooly past Ollerenshaw from close range.

The journey was ok and we knew we would get a great welcome at Spennymoor.


