



We are thrilled to announce that, as part of our new ownership's commitment to improving and modernising the matchday experience, we have made some significant changes for the 2023/24 season. These changes coincide with the implementation of our new integrated ticketing system, which will go live for our first game of the season!

#### Online Tickets

In a change from previous seasons, we are now offering discounted ticket prices to everyone who purchases their tickets online for matches at the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium. To secure the best price on single match tickets, simply visit our new ticket site and purchase your tickets. Online ticket sales will be available until shortly before kick-off (online ticket sales will close 2 hours prior). Then, on matchday, all you need to do is show up at the turnstiles, have your e-ticket scanned on your phone, and you're in! It's that simple.

#### In-person Tickets

We will continue to offer on-the-day in-person ticket sales for the 2023/24 season. However, the price of these tickets will be slightly higher compared to our online option. Please note that payment at the turnstiles will no longer be available. Instead, on-the-day in-person ticket purchases will be facilitated through our new ticket booth at the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium. The ticket booth will accept both cash and card payments. Once you've obtained your ticket, you can proceed to the turnstiles as usual for ticket scanning and entry.

#### **WELCOME TO CHORLEY FC MATCHDAY PROGRAMME**

In addition to the ticket purchasing changes, we have revised our admission categories for the first time since 2019. To address instances where individuals deliberately attempted to purchase tickets incorrectly to gain access to cheaper admission prices, we have simplified the process to ensure fairness for all supporters. From now on, anyone aged 18 to 64 will be classified as an adult and will be required to purchase an adult admission ticket.

We obtained quotes, calculated costs for supporters and looked at a potential list of volunteers to assist. Ultimately the stumbling block was the latter. The players would be thrilled to see a coach full of supporters behind the goals for our away games and so would the Trust. Unfortunately, our small band of volunteers aren't quite big enough to administrate such a project to every away game – Which is something we believe it should be, everyone, not certain ones.

This leads me nicely on to the next topic – Volunteers. At present our bank of volunteers, not including board members, stands at 4. Do you think you have a certain skillset that could help us achieve our goals? #### Membership Update


Our membership numbers stand at 95.

On Saturday, February 17 for our fixture versus Southport and during the weeks building up, we are going to be working together to support Hannah - the wife of our towering centre forward, Jack Sampson.

Just before Christmas, Hannah was dealt some devastating news and we as a club would like to do all that we can to support Hannah and Jack through what is without doubt a very difficult period in their life.

Sampo and Hannah have put together a few words to give an update.

"Unfortunately, December brought unexpected challenges into our life that we never anticipated.

My wife, Hannah, was unfortunately diagnosed with triple negative breast cancer aged 30.

Triple negative breast cancer tends to be more aggressive and has a higher likelihood of recurrence compared to other types of breast cancer.

As we prepare for the upcoming treatments and the inevitable time away from work, the financial strain has become an additional worry for us. Hannah also anticipates the emotional toll of losing her hair during chemotherapy, prompting the need for a wig to help her maintain a sense of normality.

In light of these challenges, we are reaching out to you for support. We have started a fundraising campaign to help alleviate the financial burden that comes with battling cancer. Your generosity will go towards securing a wig, and ensuring that we can focus on Hannah's recovery without the added stress of financial worry.

A portion of the funds raised will also be donated to a reputable breast cancer charity.

By supporting this cause, not only are you helping me and Hannah navigate this difficult chapter, but you are also contributing to the broader fight against breast cancer.

I understand that times are tough for everyone, and any amount you can contribute will make a meaningful impact.


#### What happens with the funds?

# **HYTHE TOWN 1**

#### EMBERY (31')

CHORLEY battled from a goal behind to come back and win 1-2 away against Hythe Town to progress into the fifth round of the Isuzu FA Trophy.

The Magpies struggled to settle into the contest in the early stages, the conditions at Reachfields Stadium playing a big part in the tie right from minute one.

It was to be the Cannon's who had the first big opportunity of the afternoon, Matt Urwin called into action and somehow keeping the ball out of his net with an outstanding save with his leg after initially being wrong-footed.

Andy Preece's side began to find pockets of space and looked dangerous on the counter-attack, largely down Justin Johnson's left-wing but were dealt a sucker punch on the half-hour mark - **JAKE EMBERY** poking the ball home from close range after a deflection forced Urwin to parry the ball out initially.

Chorley, to their credit, did react well to going a goal behind and immediately went in search for an equaliser - both Ollie Shenton and Johnson knocking on the door before Mark Ellis forced Steve Phillips into a smart save from a corner.

The Magpies were rewarded for their attacking efforts before half-time though, JACK **HAZLEHURST** firing the ball home perfectly past Phillips with the outside of his foot into the far corner on 44 minutes.

# 2 CHORLEY FC

#### HAZLEHURST (44'), SAMPSON (74')

Chorley came out firing and looked all but set to score barely a minute into the second-half, only for Johnson to be flagged offside by the referee but the signs were there - Ellis again coming almightily close to getting on the scoresheet, Phillips somehow keeping the ball out along with the Hythe defence.

JACK SAMPSON then went on to score the Magpies' second goal of the afternoon to complete the comeback, firing the ball in after Hazlehurst's initial free-kick wasn't fully cleared away.

Hythe then looked to attack with urgency as time began to run out for them but Andy Preece's side stood firm and managed the intensity of the Cannons' excellently right through to the final whistle to put themselves into the hat for the fifth round of the Isuzu FA Trophy.

There was a warm welcome from everyone at Hythe and we wished them all the best for the rest of the season.


