



We are thrilled to announce that, as part of our new ownership's commitment to improving and modernising the matchday experience, we have made some significant changes for the 2023/24 season. These changes coincide with the implementation of our new integrated ticketing system, which will go live for our first game of the season!

Online Tickets

In a change from previous seasons, we are now offering discounted ticket prices to everyone who purchases their tickets online for matches at the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium. To secure the best price on single match tickets, simply visit our new ticket site and purchase your tickets. Online ticket sales will be available until shortly before kick-off (online ticket sales will close 2 hours prior). Then, on matchday, all you need to do is show up at the turnstiles, have your e-ticket scanned on your phone, and you're in! It's that simple.

In-person Tickets

We will continue to offer on-the-day in-person ticket sales for the 2023/24 season. However, the price of these tickets will be slightly higher compared to our online option. Please note that payment at the turnstiles will no longer be available. Instead, on-the-day in-person ticket purchases will be facilitated through our new ticket booth at the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium. The ticket booth will accept both cash and card payments. Once you've obtained your ticket, you can proceed to the turnstiles as usual for ticket scanning and entry.

I'd like to welcome everyone back to the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium this afternoon for our match against Blyth Spartans.



CHORLEY'S winning streak on home soil came to a crashing end on Saturday afternoon as Andy Preece's side were beaten 0-3 by promotion-chasing, Boston United.

The Magpies didn't come out of the blocks quickly and found themselves up against it after seven minutes, Max Dearnley picking the ball out of his net after **JIMMY KNOWLES** converted from the spot - the former colliding with Knowles, leaving referee Ben Robinson with no choice but to award a penalty.

Having gone a goal behind, Chorley looked to get back into the game quickly by playing on the front-foot in attacking areas - Jack Hazlehurst proving a real handful to the Pilgrim's defence and had the best of the Magpies' half-chances throughout the opening 45 minutes.

Andy Preece found himself scratching his head on the half-hour mark though, Ethan Sephton getting to the byline before crossing - which evaded everyone before falling into **KNOWLES's** path, for him to double his tally for the afternoon and tap home at the back post.

Knowles very nearly grabbed his hat-trick barely over a minute later, trying a speculative lob from distance to try and catch Dearnley off his line but his effort sailed just wide.

However, **KNOWLES** would go on and grab his third goal of the afternoon before the break - firing

a shot low and hard from an acute which found it's way under Dearnley and into the corner to leave Chorley with a mountain to climb at the break.

The Magpies were handed a lifeline after the restart, Frankie Maguire taken out by Brad Nicholson inside the box but Justin Johnson couldn't convert from the spot - his spot kick from 12-yards, dragged wide.

To their credit, the Magpies did continue to persist in looking for a goal to get back into the game, Gregory pulling out a save right from the top drawer to deny Johnson from distance.

The real killer blow for Chorley was then to lose Jack Hazlehurst in the 84th minute, the attacking midfielder sent off with a straight red having been adjudged to have gone in too late on Kelsey Mooney.

CHORLEY secured a dominant 3-0 win against Scarborough Athletic side on Saturday afternoon, three goals for the Magpies enough to seal a big win for Andy Preece's side to extend the Magpies' winning run at home to seven straight home wins in the Vanarama National League North.

The Magpies started the game well, but it looked all but set to be goalless at half-time only for **JACK HAZLEHURST** to pull out an absolute stunner in the first minute of stoppage time, driving towards goal before placing a wicked shot perfectly into the top corner past Ryan Whitley who stood no chance.

Andy Preece's side continued to push on after the restart and one goal quickly became two before the hour mark, **MIKE CALVELEY** tapping home his ninth goal of the season after a headed flick on from Jack Sampson inside the six-yard box.

The momentum continued to swing in Chorley's favour after scoring their second, Sampson heading one barely an inch wide of the post before ex-Scarborough man,

Kieran Glynn saw his curling effort well-saved by Whitley.

Scarborough had one big opportunity and even that was cleared off the line brilliantly by Adam Henley, Harry Green firing off a powerful effort through a group of bodies only to be denied by the former.

Chorley then sealed the win with five minutes to go, **CARLTON UBAEZUONU** taking down the ball brilliantly with his back to goal before spinning his man and firing a shot past Whitley to add the Magpies' third of the afternoon.
