

THE Magpies produced an excellent second half display to knock back the challenge of playoff rivals Hereford on a cold night at HQ.

Chorley started the better of the two teams with some good early pressure but Matt Urwin was first called into action, saving spectacularly from Ryan Lloyd's 10-yard effort.

Tyrone Barnett and Ryan McLean had chances before half-time, the latter twice going close, and the visitors were arguably unfortunate not to have a goal for their efforts going in at the break.

The Magpies came out for the second half with real attacking intent and **Jon Ustabaşı** picked up from where he left off on Saturday at Spennymoor, unleashing a fierce effort off Adam Henley's cross that flew past Dino Visser before the Hereford keeper could move.

## **HEREFORD 0**

Barely a minute later the home side found themselves two to the good, **Connor Hall** slotting home his 19th league goal of the season after Ustabaşı had his initial effort saved.

The Bulls continued to push for a way back into the game but Urwin continued to star in goal, this time saving at full-stretch from Miles Storey's shot. The game was won by this point, however, as Andy Preece's side went on to secure a vital three points in the playoff race.



The board and members of the Magpies Trust (formerly Chorley FC Supporters Trust) have been working on a number of things recently.

You may have seen our new banners at the Pilling Lane End – and we have now taken over the old Pica Pica cabin near the social club on the Ashby Road side of Victory Park. The cabin will always be staffed on match-days and here you can pick up a copy of our latest newsletter and also buy current and previous printed match programmes.

We have funded new jackets for match stewards, to help keep them warm on cold days and evenings!

Magpies Trust has been running the match-day 'Golden Goal' draw for a long time, with a chance to win a cash prize if you draw the ticket with the correct time for the first goal of the match. 
