

In the end, it just wasn't to be.



SUPPORTERS TRUST

We have previously used this column to introduce members of the trust board and this week it's PETE THOMPSON...

Role in Trust: Vice -Chair of Chorley FC Supporters Trust. Supporter Director at Chorley FC.

Where do you live? I lived in Bolton until October 2022, when I moved to Coppull.

First Chorley match? I don't remember it because I was two or three years old! My dad took me to a match at VP and I embarrassed him by invading the pitch in pursuit of the ball (this was back in the early 1960s – no fence round the pitch to prevent toddler incursions).

Do you support any other teams? I spent several years of my childhood in Northern Ireland and went to see Coleraine a few times. Still have a soft spot for them and keep an eye on how they are doing. I spent my early adult years in Truro so also check on Truro City's results. I was born in Chorley, though – so Chorley FC come first, always.

Other interests outside of football? I enjoy reading and walking (though rarely at the same time). I'm director of a film, arts and media community interest company in Bolton and have been involved in a number of community fund-raising projects, which I enjoy.

What's your day job? I'm a freelance writer and editor. My main income is from an educational consultancy - for whom I write, review and edit questions for their artificial intelligence-based training program. I also do various other types of authoring and journalism.

Favourite Player of all time? Tough one, but I returned to Lancashire and started watching Chorley again several years ago when James Dean was in the squad and knocking 'em in on a regular basis – so I'd

have to say Deano.

Favourite Player in the current squad? As a club director I think it may be undiplomatic to say. I think we have a lot of good players in our squad at the moment.

Where do you sit/stand on matchdays? Director's box – but I usually have a walk round the ground during a match. Prior to joining the board my favourite vantage was pitch-side in front of the main stand, near the dugouts.

What has been your favourite Chorley F.C. Chorley F.C. memory? The 2-0 away win at Buxton which secured the Northern Premier League title for us was a great day. The Spennymoor play-off final was even more tense than the Buxton game but turned out well – eventually! I was at Boston United for that incredible Adam Roscoe 'worldie' in the play-offs – standing behind the goal. Was on the point of accepting defeat and wandering off for a smoke when that happened.

How did you become involved with the Supporters' Trust? I was contacted by Mark Rees out of the blue, apparently on the recommendation of Ryan Modlin, who had probably seen my social media profile showing previous board-level experience. I had no hesitation in accepting the offer and have enjoyed being part of the Trust set-up ever since. Within a year or so of joining I had been elected as a Trust representative on the board of Chorley FC, and I was Trust chair for a while.
