at home what we've been able to do in the last two away games. A positive side of things we're now five unbeaten after opening day and have quickly moved up the table into a good initial position.


We've just got to try and be more clinical in our home games, hopefully starting this afternoon against Kevin Wilkin's Brackley Town, who we welcome to Victory Park.

What we have done throughout the opening month of the season is defend really well. That's come through especially in the last two games with the two clean sheets.



Chorley came out of the blocks quickly and very nearly got off to the perfect start; Scott Wilson forcing a save from George Sykes-Kenworthy before Ollie Shenton hit the side-netting with a well hit volley.

The visitors' first real chance of the afternoon came from Shane Maroodza who broke well from deep but eventually crossed into nobody as Matt Urwin grabbed the ball comfortably.

Shenton came close to breaking the deadlock once more just before the break, though the real action came between Maroodza and Matt Challoner – the former red carded and the latter cautioned for an altercation after a foul.

Andy Preece's side continued pressed for a breakthrough throughout the second period, with Connor Hall going closest following a great interception and pass from Mike Calveley.

THE Magpies produced a gutsy, disciplined display to end Alfreton's unbeaten start to the season at The Impact Arena.

The first half was an even affair with possession flowing equally between the two teams. The best chances for the Magpies fell to Connor Hall, who worked George Willis at his near post, and Adam Blakeman; a spinning free kick that Willis did well to stop.

At the other end, the home side created a half chance that top scorer Tom Denton headed wide (before he departed with an injury) and Dayle Southwell shot straight at Matt Urwin when given half a yard in the right channel.

Chorley began the second half with a bit more purpose, digging out two decent opportunities in the opening 15 minutes. A well-worked corner routine saw Mike Calveley head wide, before a Will Tomlinson pass released Jon Ustabaşı only for Willis to stand big to deny the winger.

Ustabaşı wasn't to be denied on 77 minutes,

however. Sub Joe Nolan picked the number 11 out with a delightful pass; the touch inside the defender was sublime before the finish hit Willis and looped into the empty net.

A second followed just before the end to put the icing on the cake. Jack Sampson turned inside and saw his shot hit the post. Ustabaşı's rebound was saved by Willis, but the second rebound was calmly put away by Ollie Shenton – sealing a deserved and hard-fought three points.



A warm welcome to everyone associated with Brackley Town for this afternoon's National League North match. Our normally ultraconsistent visitors have recovered from an unexpectedly shaky start to the new season and will no doubt provide us with another stiff test.

There has never been much between today's two

teams in recent meetings (nor many goals) and it will be interesting to see if the trend is maintained today. Brackley warmed up for this one with maximum points from the Bank Holiday double-header, winning 1-0 at Gloucester and then recording an eye-catching 2-0 victory at home to highly-fancied Kidderminster on Monday.

Our victory at Alfreton on Monday was a real tonic. It's always tricky to successfully handle Alfreton's aerial approach and lofty strike-force and the players deserve enormous credit for doing so in our 2-0 victory.

The early table shows relegated King's Lynn leading the field with 16 points from the opening six games. Demoted sides don't always hit the ground running in the lower tier. No surprise to see Banbury United right up there in second place on 13 points after running away with the Southern League title last term, while also-promoted Scarborough Athletic stand fourth (11 points).

Fylde who lost to both Banbury and Scarborough in the early matches are back on track now in third with four wins. It's ridiculously early to be talking of play-off slots but only an extra goal scored by

Alfreton is keeping us out of seventh place.

Another promoted club, Northern Premier League champions Buxton, now under Jamie Vermiglio's guidance, are not finding life in National North quite so easy. They are 19th with one win and three draws. In fact, draws are a major feature of scorelines in this division so far this season. Spennymoor lead

the way with four draws out of six, while there are a further seven teams (including Chorley) who have drawn three times. The bottom two, Bradford Park Avenue and Boston United, both without a win, have at least drawn three of their six matches.

Our defensive record bears comparison with the best:

only leaders King's Lynn and Leamington, who have both conceded three, better our total of four.

Can we extend our points tally into double figures this afternoon? Enjoy the game and don't forget to get right behind your team!


