THE Magpies fell to defeat on the road against fellow playoff chasers Banbury United.

The visitors bossed long spells of the first half, with Connor Hall testing Jack Harding early on, collecting a high through ball from Jon Ustabaşı before striking the chest of the onrushing Jack Harding in the Banbury goal.

Ustabaşı also went close with a wicked drive from range that just cleared the bar, before the home side's skipper Gio Rasulo tested Matt Urwin with a 25 yard free kick. Otherwise, it was an arms length type of opening 45 minutes.

Unfortunately, within 30 seconds of the restart Banbury were ahead. Jack Stevens swaying his way through the Chorley backline before planting his effort under Urwin.

The home side were now in command; Rasulo saw a free kick fly just over Urwin's bar and Alex Babos tested the goalie's reflexes after twisting into space down the right channel.

Leather was dismissed for a second booking – the resulting Rasulo free kick brilliantly saved by Urwin.

The third and final goal two minutes later from Rasulo, another low strikes from the edge of the penalty area, added insult to injury.



THE Magpies won an Isuzu FA Trophy tie for the first time since 2017, reaching the third round with a 1-0 win over Leek Town.

Chorley nearly got off to a perfect start; Connor Hall firing an audacious volley against the bar from Callum Schorah's looped pass from the left.

Hall came mightily close again minutes later, this time his effort from inside the box cleared off the line following Will Tomlinson's pinpoint corner.

Both sides looked like going in level at the break but for a blistering 50-yard run from Justin Johnson to set up Jack Sampson for the opener – the latter tapping home a rebound after Johnson's initial effort was saved.

The Magpies continued to dominate into the second half and it took Leek 65 minutes to register their first shot of the game; Daniel Trickett-Smith's free kick well held by Matt Urwin.

To their credit, the visitors did look for a way back into the game late, with Urwin alert to repel a Lucas Baker shot. But they were no match for Andy



A GRANDSTAND VIEW

BACK FOR THE 2022/23 SEASON

We extend a very warm welcome to today's visitors Curzon Ashton for this National League North match, which like the majority of the rest of the programme has an early lunchtime kick-off.

Curzon currently stand 16th in the table, five places below ourselves. Apart from last Saturday's 3-0

home win against bottomof-the-league Telford, they have found three points hard to come by in the last couple of months but remain hard to beat. Games in which they feature tend to be low-scoring affairs, typically the recent one at Brackley where the hosts won by the only goal of the game in the closing minutes.

The stats for the Nash read F18 A16, suggesting that last Saturday's three-goals' spree was somewhat out of character. Clearly Curzon are very sound defensively, as was evidenced in the recent FA Cup battle against Cambridge United when they played 210 minutes over the two games without conceding a goal, only to lose lucklessly on penalties. That was a really fine effort against a League One side.

Closer to home we are now one of only two teams unbeaten at home. King's Lynn are the only other side with a similar claim, following Scarborough Athletic's home loss to much-improved Chester last Saturday. That said, an improvement to our away record would be most welcome; we have to go back to August for our last success (at Alfreton) which followed immediately after the tremendous 4-1 win at Boston. Since then we have drawn at

Peterborough Sports and lost five, including three on the bounce most recently. One thing's for sure, Andy and the players will be giving everything to end the sequence on our next trip to Hereford on Tuesday, ahead of four more difficult trips to close out 2022 at Blyth Spartans, Notts County, Buxton & AFC Fylde.

CLOSE TO HOME WE ARE NOW ONE OF ONLY TWO TEAMS UNBEATEN AT HOME. KING'S LYNN ARE THE ONLY OTHER SIDE WITH A SIMILAR CLAIM.

Looking at the table, early table-toppers King's Lynn now need to concentrate on restoring their advantage after their FA Cup adventure, if they are to overhaul leaders Brackley, who are looking solid once more after their early-season struggles. And look out for Fylde who have run into form and are mounting another title

challenge. Darlington too are a serious threat this term and are showing the required consistency.

At the bottom, the relegation battle is taking clearer shape. It's surprising to find Telford propping up the table, their only victory (1-0) coming on the opening day against...would you believe it, our own Magpies. Familiar faces from last season's basement include Blyth, Farsley Celtic and Bradford Park Avenue, with Kettering Town on the fringe. The Poppies' problems stem from a very poor away record – they have yet to win on the road.

Enjoy today's game – and don't forget to get right behind your team! Three points from any game in this tight league can have an immediate significant impact on league placings.
