

THE Magpies made it six unbeaten in the Vanarama National League North with a gutsy win against Darlington at Victory Park.

Darlington started the better of the two sides, Will Hatfield stinging the palms of Matt Urwin early on. Connor Hall set up Mike Calveley for the Magpies' first real chance of the afternoon, as he found space down the left then shot low and hard towards Tommy Taylor.

Chorley found themselves up against it at times in the opening half hour but hit the front first with a bit of fortune, Ben Hedley heading into his own net after an initial headed flick on by Scott Leather from a Jon Ustabaşı centre.

The Quakers came out with serious attacking intent in the second half, Kevin Dos Santos somehow firing over after twisting and turning past two defenders inside the box.

Calveley came close to extending Chorley's advantage but couldn't direct his header goalwards and Darlington took full advantage of the missed

THE Andy Preece era as Chorley manager began with a narrow defeat at AFC Telford United as the 2022/23 Vanarama National League North season got underway.

Both sides took a while to settle into the contest, Jack Sampson's tame header straight at Luke Pilling the only real opening of the first half hour.

The hosts hit the front right before the breakthrough Devarn Green, who capitalised on an unfortunate slip from Scott Leather to smash the ball home past Matt Urwin from 10 yards.

Andy Preece's side came out for the second half with work to do, though the first piece of action was a yellow card for Sampson for what looked like a well-timed tackle on Robbie Evans.

Sam McLintock then went close for the Bucks, a whisker away from bending one into the corner past Urwin, but that was as close as the home side got in the second 45 minutes as the visitors tried to push on.

Connor Hall forced a strong save out of Pilling

after he found space to shoot just outside the box, before a second challenge on Evans by Sampson eventually saw the Chorley number nine given his marching orders.






