

THE Magpies came from behind twice to grab a point against Buxton in a lively encounter at the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium.

On a bitterly cold day neither side really got going in the opening 20 minutes. There were plenty of headers and tackles won, and the odd set piece floated into the box, otherwise it was a tough watch.

Buxton should have taken the lead on the half hour, however, after Jack Sampson's foul on Warren Clarke produced a penalty, Matt Urwin brilliantly saved Tom Elliott's spot kick, before standing big to shut down the rebound, preserving the tie.

Then, as time expired in the first half, the visitors deservedly hit the front. Jak McCourt's free kick dropped at the back post and eventually found the boot of sub Declan Poole who dispatched from a yard out.

The second half was all over the place as the fouls and chances clicked up a notch or five. Chorley were in the ascendancy for much of it, and after Theo Richardson saved superbly from Scott Wilson, Andy Preece's men finally grabbed an equaliser.

Wilson was the architect, as his 70th minute ball into the box fell to the boot of Connor Hall, who did the rest from five yards. The euphoria lasted less than two minutes as Warren Clarke headed the Bucks back into the lead, as the game continued to twist and turn.

The Magpies didn't give up, however, and when sub Harry Scarborough was felled in the box by away skipper Josh Granite, Hall levelled matters from 12 yards to secure a much-deserved point.



THE Magpies went down to just a third home league defeat of the season against a spirited Boston United.

Matt Urwin was first to be called into action, saving brilliantly from a towering header by Luke Shiels, as the visitors looked to set the tone early on.

Chorley did look the better of the two sides in the opening 20 minutes and didn't have to wait long to break the deadlock – Harvey Smith stabbing the ball in from a couple of yards out in a goal-mouth scramble.

Boston began to grow into the game after the goal, Urwin again the saviour to deny Billy Chadwick but Jake Wright did get his side back on terms before half-time, slamming home confidently after a slick move on the edge of the box.

The visitors came out of the blocks quickly after the restart with two goals inside the opening eight minutes; Wright at the double for the evening before Chadwick doubled Boston's lead with a smart finish.

Scott Wilson very nearly got the Magpies back in the game with an audacious effort on the turn, hitting the post from the edge of the box.

Connor Hall grabbed his 18th league goal of the season with ten minutes left, curling home a Harry Scarborough pass from 20 yards to set up a grandstand finish. But it proved to be too little, too late as the relegation-threatened Pilgrims held on for a vital three points.



This evening's National League North fixture brings Hereford to the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium and we extend a warm welcome to the Bulls' players, management team and everyone associated with the club.

In the first meeting we snatched a point with a late goal from Harvey Smith and we will be looking to try to improve on that with three points

today. But we face a tough test. Hereford picked up six points recently with back-to-back wins on the road, a stunning 3-1 win at Mill Farm against Fylde and a 1-0 success at Southport. It was Fylde's first defeat in 2023 and the first since we beat them at Mill Farm on Boxing Day. All of which underlines the consistency of

the Coasters who now top the table on 66 points from 32 games. Two clear of King's Lynn (64) who have played one match more. The Linnets have shown a few cracks in their form of late and must be considered second-favourites at this stage.

On the rise are Chester, now third on 59 points. They picked up a solid win at Hereford last Tuesday and cannot be entirely discounted in their bid to finish at least second. We are hanging on in seventh at the time of going to print but Alfreton in particular are in a position to overtake us, four points behind us but with three matches in hand.

The real drama is being played out at the foot of the table. Boston United did themselves a huge favour by winning here last Tuesday and moving three points clear of the drop-zone. On the night they looked anything but relegation candidates. That left Farsley Celtic, Bradford Park Avenue and Leamington all on 34 points, 14 clear of last-placed Telford whose fate would appear to be sealed now. Bradford were not too long ago mounting a

recovery but have slipped back, something which is all too easy to do when you are fighting relegation, while Leamington are clearly on the slide into trouble and desperately need a win. In contrast, Kettering who spent many months waiting for a first away win, are on something of a roll and now have 41 points, which gives

them real cause for optimism.

Great to see Connor Hall add to his impressive goals-haul last Tuesday with a wonderful strike which took him to 21 goals in all competitions and also maintained his lead at the top of the National North scoring chart.

Enjoy the game – and don't forget to get right behind your team!

We continue with our series of 'Meet the Trust Board' articles and today it is the turn of our chairman, Jue Vass.

Name: Julian Vass (Known around Victory Park as Jue)

Role: Chair

Where do you live? Haydock - Yes, there is more than a racecourse in Haydock!

First Chorley match? I would absolutely love to be able to answer this question but I can't - mainly because when I first visited Victory Park I used to spend my time playing football on the grass banking rather than watching the actual game. I do know it was around 2000, when we played in the then Northern Premier League Division 1. The first season I remember taking an actual interest in the football was during the 2002/2003 campaign when we made the play-offs.

Do you support any other teams? My first-choice team prior to Chorley was Blackburn Rovers. My Dad took me to Ewood Park as a youngster and I did see them lift silverware in Cardiff in a game which saw a certain Matt Jansen on the scoresheet. Up until recently, I had only been to one other live Rovers game which was in 2019. This season I have taken advantage of their FA Cup run and have seen them beat Birmingham City and Leicester - both away. Long story short, I do hope they do well.

Anything else we should know about you? I'm a family man with a Mrs and 2 very energetic children; not quite ready to add the dog into that mix as it's already tiring enough! Massive geek at heart with all things Marvel and Harry Potter taking over our house.

Let's talk Magpies Trust. How did you get involved? I first got involved in the original Supporters Club when I was around 16 years old, attending meetings and giving my suggestions. My biggest help would be taking part in the sponsored walks to Bamber Bridge every year, which raised money for both the Supporters Club and a local charity. I've been involved with the Trust since it's amalgamation with the Supporters Club, whether that be as a board member or as a volunteer. It's really easy to get involved and something I am keen to get across to other supporters.

We purchased medical equipment for the club, equipment to improve the playing surface and more recently kitted out the stewards with new winter coats. We also own 9.5% of the club and have 2 seats on the board.






