A WORD FROM THE MANAGER

Hello once again everyone to the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium for our Remembrance Weekend fixture against Kettering Town, as we remember those who lost their lives while serving the UK around the globe.

We welcome Lee Glover and everyone connected with Kettering to this afternoon's game. We know from last season's encounters with the Poppies just how tough a battle today's game will be.

We did very well to put Kettering away at our place this time last year, before they reversed that on their patch in March.

Obviously, we have to back ourselves, like we did on Tuesday night against Spennymoor. It was massively important to respond to the disappointment of Saturday's defeat at Southport in the right manner, and we did just that.

I thought we were excellent from the off on Tuesday and got a thoroughly deserved three points. Spennymoor are very tricky opponents with some real quality running through their side, but we nullified the threat and saw the game off in a very pleasing way.

We now need your help in sustaining this run of home form by supporting the lads and also getting the message out about our games – especially our three home games during the World Cup shutdown. The more people that come down, the better chance we have of continuing to compete in an incredible difficult division.

THE Magpies eased to a third straight home win with a routine 2-0 success against Spennymoor Town.

Less than four minutes elapsed before the home side took the lead. Adam Blakeman and Jack Sampson combined to free Ollie Shenton running across the box, and the midfielder managed to sweep home beyond Gio Bellagambi from 12 yards.

Billy Whitehouse hit the sidenetting of Bellagambi's goal soon after, following a storming run by Jon Ustabaşı, who in turn swiped an effort just wide from distance.

The flying winger then sped past Finn Cousin-Dawson and worked Bellagambi low as the one-way traffic continued right through to half time.

The visitors upped the pressure at the start of the second half, finally registering a shot on goal after 58 minutes, but it mattered little as Chorley's second goal appeared on 63 minutes.

Connor Hall put Shenton in down the left and his beautifully dinked cross found an

unmarked Ustabaşı who volley past Bellagambi for his ninth of the season.

A final 20 minute cruise to three points was made harder when Billy Whitehouse picked up two yellows in 11 minutes, giving Moors some momentum heading into the final exchanges.

Sub Joe Cummings headed wide right after the dismissal, and although it looked as though the visitors had enough in the tank to mount some sort of challenge, the game thankfully died away leaving the Magpies with three valuable points.

The Magpies' pressure on the Port goal was eventually rewarded on 28 minutes when Jon Ustabaşı curled home a delicious strike past Tony McMillan from 25 yards.

Will Tomlinson forced a strong save out of McMillan and Mike Calveley had a header cleared off the line as the visitors exerted more pressure ahead of the interval, but it was Southport who came out firing after the restart.

A number of Josh Hmami set plays were dangerous without hitting the mark, before substitute Jordan Archer connected with a corner, heading home to level the scores with 17 minutes remaining.

MK DONS LATEST CLUB TO ADOPT SUPPORTERS' BOARD MODEL

MKDSA's Jim Mann, who chairs the board, said: "I was delighted to see that in addition to the representatives from our two supporters' groups there were an additional 100 applicants from our supporter base who applied to have a place on the board.

"After a rigorous interview process we now have a board of highly skilled individuals who have come together with the joint objective of working with the club to improve the supporter experience and provide a sounding board for the club on its future plans.

"We all look forward to laying the foundations of this new initiative and creating a strong and lasting relationship with the club to ensure that the supporters' have a voice in all important decisions."
