THE Magpies came from behind to claim a valuable three points at relegation-threatened Blyth Spartans.

The visitors bossed the first half for long periods, creating a number of very inviting opportunities in the opening 20 minutes.

Ollie Shenton was denied by the combination of Alex Mitchell and his post, before skipper-for-the-night Adam Blakeman curled a low effort agonisingly wide from 15 yards.

Connor Hall could also have been awarded a penalty after a clumsy challenge by Matt Elsdon that referee Bancroft saw as a corner.

There were warning signs at the other end with debutant goalie Matt Gould saving superbly from Cedric Main and Will McGowan. Then, Main saw space in front of him, took off, spun inside and finished low from 20 yards to give the home side a 27th minute lead.

The Magpies did well to hold their nerve after the goal and deservedly got back on terms right on the break. Will Tomlinson finding the corner of the Blyth net from 25 yards, leaving the home crowd stunned into silence.

Beginning on the front foot in the second half the visitors worked Mitchell twice through Hall and Mike Calveley, before Billy Whitehouse flashed an effort wide after Jon Ustabasi went on a trademark run through the middle of the park.

Blyth forced a few corners that Chorley did well to repel as the game slowed down. Until, after a couple of meaty challenges got the crowd going, the Magpies turned the screw. Billy Whitehouse intercepted a short pass, drove into the area and crossed low for sub Jack Sampson to tap home.

Mike Calveley, on his 100 appearance for the Magpies, was then sent off for a second booking, leaving the visitors with 10 minutes to hold on. And hold on they did, with one brilliant clearance by Scott Wilson in injury time sealing the three points.

THE Magpies weathered a heavy Brackley storm to come away from St James Park with a valuable point.

The game started at quite a lazy pace with little action in the opening 15 minutes, aside a half chance for Billy Whitehouse that Danny Lewis in the Brackley goal saved well down low.

A sustained period of low-level home pressure followed, but debutant Steve Drench remained untested through the 30 minute mark, despite close efforts from Shepherd Murombedzi and Gareth Dean.

Then, as the pressure continued, Adam Henley and Callum Stead tussled in the area, a spot kick was awarded and Levi Amantchi smashed home from 12 yards to give the home side a 35th minute lead.

Within six minutes of the restart the Magpies were level. A first quick break of the afternoon saw Jack Sampson turn Dean before being impeded while shooting. It didn't matter, however, as Connor Hall was on hand to stab home while being taken out by both Glenn Walker and goalkeeper Lewis.

The hosts were stunned by the equaliser and struggled in the aftermath to create any clear cut opportunities, despite continuing to hold most of the possession.

Livewire winger Cosmos Matwasa did get an opening 15 minutes from time but was denied by a superb goal-line Scott Wilson clearance. Drench was then called upon to take flight and deny sub Sam Smart, as the home side pushed forward in the final 10.

But the Magpies stood firm to extend their unbeaten away streak in the league to seven games.
