and, hopefully, our attitude was as spot on over the weekend at Southport.





THE Magpies survived a late scare to claim three points from a pulsating encounter with Farsley Celtic at the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium.

Jack Sampson got the Magpies off to a perfect start, slamming home a wicked shot from just inside the box on 10 minutes after Justin Johnson and Adam Blakeman combined to the forward up.

Matt Urwin then had to acrobatically deny Kian Scales from distance, before the Celts leveled on 25 minutes; Frank Mulhern firing in a free-kick off the post from 25 yards.

Sub Carlton Ubaezuonu then put the visitors in front seven minutes later, heading home from Luke Parkin's cross to turn the game temporarily on its head going into half time.

Chorley came out for the second half with work to do but got back into the game quickly thanks to Connor Hall, who tucked away a penalty he won himself for his 10th goal of the season.

Two minutes later Sampson doubled his tally to put the Magpies in control once again with a stunningly

executed overhead kick off Billv Whitehouse's centre.

Harvey Smith added a fourth goal on 63 minutes via an Adam Blakeman corner, flicking home a Scott Leather header. That looked to have wrapped the game, up but there was late drama to come.

Scott Leather was given a second yellow card as injury time came into view and Ubaezuonu got his second goal off a Mulhern cross. Thankfully it was only a consolation as the home side saw out the final minutes to claim an important win.

THE Magpies cruised into the first round proper of the Emirates FA Cup for the third season in a row with a comfortable 2-0 victory over Spennymoor Town.

The visitors started quickly, testing Matt Urwin with less than a minute on the clock. Luckily, Chorley's number one was alert to tip over Rob Ramshaw's goal-bound header. The resulting corner was blazed over by James Curtis, as Moors sought an early advantage.

The quick attacks continued, but aside from a Ben McKenna drive that flew well wide, Chorley defended with relative ease and began to build some pressure of their own.

Chris Holroyd headed straight at Matt Gould from an Adam Blakeman free kick and Alex Newby hit another set piece straight at the Moors' goalie. A Ntumba Massanka ball across the six yard box also caused problems for the National League North outfit, but just like Chorley, Spennymoor's defence dealt with everything thrown at them.

Then, just as it looked like another goalless half, Massanka was shoved in the box, referee Aaron Jackson pointed to the spot and Holroyd bagged his seventh of the season to send the Magpies into the break a goal to the good.

Moors started the second half like they did the first, and only a brilliant save by Urwin from Dan Ward kept the Magpies ahead. It was their only meaningful foray into Chorley territory before the all-important second goal put the Magpies in full control.

Adam Blakeman was fouled 30 yards from goal and up stepped Alex Newby to fire home low past Gould with the sweetest of strikes.

The visitors still possessed a threat and Urwin had to be at his best again to repel a vicious Glen Taylor free kick from 35 yards, but otherwise it was a stress free afternoon for Jamie Vermiglio's side.



The new group will meet at least four times a year and consists of two representatives from the MK Dons Supporters' Association (MKDSA), one member of Dons Action and two members of staff from Stadium MK.

Andy Gibb, MK Dons' group sales and marketing director, said: "The supporters' board, which includes representatives from our two official supporters' organisations, is still very much in its early stages and we are looking forward to seeing how the Board works in practice, and what improvements we can make by working together."

Nine other supporter representatives will make up the 2022-23 supporters' board. The club say the main purpose of the board is to provide an open, transparent and independent dialogue with the club and its supporters on all club issues and supporters' match day experience.

Every meeting will be confidential, but meeting minutes covering non-confidential matters will be published online.

MKDSA's Jim Mann, who chairs the board, said: "I was delighted to see that in addition to the representatives from our two supporters' groups there were an additional 100 applicants from our supporter base who applied to have a place on the board.

"After a rigorous interview process we now have a board of highly skilled individuals who have come together with the joint objective of working with the club to improve the supporter experience and provide a sounding board for the club on its future plans.

"We all look forward to laying the foundations of this new initiative and creating a strong and lasting relationship with the club to ensure that the supporters' have a voice in all important decisions."

















