DESPITE a stirring fightback the Magpies succumbed to three second half goals as Scarborough took the points on a chilly night by the seaside.

Chorley came out of the blocks at lightning speed; four shots and two corners in the opening five minutes offering a glimpse of what was to come, as the hosts struggled to get out of their own half.

Jack Sampson had an effort saved, Scott Leather volleyed over and Jon Ustabaşı saw an effort blocked and flash wide. There were also half chances for Ollie Shenton and Connor Hall, but the elusive opened just wouldn't materialise.

Unfortunately, despite battling well against a much better second half start from Scarborough, the home side's intensity paid dividends on 55 minutes - Kieran Weledji heading home a Lewis Maloney free-kick to give Jonathan Greening's team the lead.

Michael Coulson doubled Boro's lead three minutes later, tapping home from close range after Luca Colville's initial effort was well saved by Matt Urwin.

Maloney then capped a manic nine minutes with the third on 64. His dipping free kick from 25 yards giving Urwin no chance and seemingly finishing off the visitors.

Chorley did get one back as they looked for a lifeline in the game, Connor Hall bagging his fourth of the campaign with a smart header from Matt Challoner's cross.

Ustabaşı then cut the deficit further in stoppage time after a Leather header was saved by Joe Cracknell, but Scarborough just held on to secure a slightly fortuitous win.

THE Magpies set up a Third Qualifying Round tie against Blyth Spartans after cruising to a 9-0 replay win against Liversedge at the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium.

A lightning start saw the home side take a third minute lead. Adam Blakeman's corner found an unmarked Scott Leather, and his goalbound header was deflected home by Jon Ustabaşı.

After a slight lull in the action the Magpies found the all-important second midway through the half. Billy Whitehouse with the whipped cross for Ollie Shenton to apply the headed finish.

An Ustabaşı drive over the bar and a Connor Hall header wide aside, that was it for the first half action. The second half to come was nothing but astonishing.

It took the home side eight minutes to add to their lead after the restart. Blakeman sent Shenton clear and Porter brought the midfielder down for a penalty that Hall dispatched with ease.

Hall added a fourth on 67 minutes, clinically dispatching a Mike Calveley through ball, before

an own goal followed soon after from a Blakeman cross. The scoring continued with a smart Ustabaşı finish after being released on goal by Whitehouse. Was then extended by Whitehouse himself, finding the top corner after Porter saved from Leather, and by Ustabaşı's hat trick goal; a flicked header off Justin Johnson's centre.

Finally, minutes after he'd missed the hosts second penalty of the night, Will Tomlinson rounded off the scoring with a 40-yard lob of Porter after the keeper had raced from his goal to tackle sub Callum Schorah. Job done.

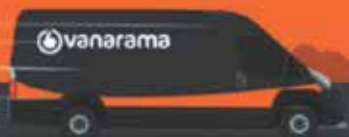
