

THE Magpies came from behind twice to snatch a point against Chester on an entertaining night at the Chorley Group Victory Park Stadium.

The visitors started on the front foot with an early chance falling to Kurt Willoughby who dragged his shot wide, while Chorley struggled to settle themselves into the contest.

Lewis Coulton then found space out wide and dug out a delicious cross to find Adam Thomas at the back post who headed past Matt Urwin smartly to give Chester the lead on 16 minutes.

Ollie Shenton saw an effort curl over as the Magpies looked for a way back into the game, before Thomas fired a looping effort onto the crossbar just before the break.

Chorley wouldn't have to wait long to get back on terms after the restart, Shenton supplying an assist out of the top drawer to put Hall through and he did the rest, finishing past Harry Tyrer for an eighth of the season.

# CHORLEY 1 REILLY 19'

## THE Magpies produced a gutsy display in awful conditions to seal a place in the Fourth Round Qualifying of the Emirates FA Cup.

The rain was hammering down as the game started and continued for much of the first half, leaving little room for error on the slickest of surfaces. The visitors created a couple of half-chances that Matt Urwin had to deal with, before a Chorley corner from Sam Walker saw Harry Cardwell fouled, the ref point to the spot and Lewis Reilly confidently beat Pete Jameson from 12 yards.

The Magpies were very much in the ascendancy, but try as they might, couldn't fashion any more clear-cut openings. Cardwell flashed an effort wide and Reilly was close to connecting with a Mike Calveley nod back in the six yard box.

At the other end Ollie Dyson came closest to an equaliser, but his turn and shot from Scott Barrow's centre hit the bar and bounced clear of danger.

As the rain eased off at the start of the second half, so did the chances. The Magpies kept their shape, battled superbly, and when York did get the ball into dangerous

areas it was by-and-large a Chorley body that got to it first.

Snap shots for Birch and Ollie Shenton aside, the attacking purpose came from the visitors, although it was rarely overwhelming to deal with. Set pieces were the main danger, with the two best second half chances coming off superb balls into the box. One was the width of the post away from an equaliser, another forced Matt Urwin to stand tall to repel the danger.

The threat of a late Minstermen onslaught never materialised as Chorley dug deep, ran themselves into the ground and finished the night in the Fourth Round Qualifying draw hat for a fourth season on the spin.

**Favourite Player in the current squad?** I'm a big fan of professionalism, especially given we're part-time. For that reason, Scott Leather. I think he brings so much more than his defensive capabilities.

Where do you sit/stand on matchdays? Well, I'm really lucky to get a seat in the Directors box. I'm a big fan of inclusivity & diversity, so many times I'll head behind the goal to watch with friends, or head round to wherever the sun is with a tray of chips and a lovely pint of Tetley's (and yes, I'm 31 and drink Tetleys, ha!) personal reasons, was Chorley beating Kendal to win the Lancashire Junior Cup at Bolton in 2012. I had never seen them win that trophy and my Dad was there and I am pretty sure it was the last match he went to. It meant a lot to me for a number of different reasons.



# A GRANDSTAND

BACK FOR THE 2022/23 SEASON

Today we extend a very warm welcome to everyone associated with Blyth Spartans Football Club ahead of this afternoon's FA Cup Third Round Qualifying tie. The Spartans are making a quick return visit to Chorley, having fought out a 1-1 draw in the National North fixture played here last month.

The winners of today's tie will be just one match away from a place in the First Round Proper of the competition and the chance of playing a club from League One or League Two. Prize-money for the winners of third round qualifying ties is a healthy £5,625, while those exiting the FA Cup at this stage will collect £1,875.

Two other ties of local interest are at Clitheroe and Bamber Bridge. The former, who have never progressed further than this round, will host the newly-formed Bury AFC in a tie which has a measure of magic attached to it and should pull in a sizeable crowd of supporters from both camps. Over at Irongate, Bamber Bridge will entertain Jamie Vermiglio's Buxton, familiar surroundings for the former Magpies' manager.

On the league front, September has seen a slightly more regular pattern developing with some of the 'big guns' settling into familiar positions at the top end of the table. Although last season's National League members King's Lynn Town and Southern League champions Banbury United have made a very strong start, Kidderminster Harriers and AFC Fylde are moving ominously into contention, the latter now the bookmakers' favourites for the title.

Keep an eye too on Darlington who look set for a promotion push after two or three relatively quiet seasons. They are now right among the leaders after Tuesday's late, late winner against Blyth.











