



## Registration U.S. Student

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Registration must be completed at least two months prior to the requested course start date.

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### Application Documents

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Please submit the following Step 1 documents to reserve your space in a class:

- Completed Application
- Copy of your FAA Medical Certificate<sup>1</sup>

Prior to enrollment you will need to get your FAA Medical with any AME doctor. To register for your medical, go to: [https://www.faa.gov/licenses\\_certificates/medical\\_certification/get/](https://www.faa.gov/licenses_certificates/medical_certification/get/)

- Copy of your Photo Identification and Passport or Birth Certificate

Please submit the following Step 2 documents to complete your registration process:

- \$227 Registration Fee<sup>2</sup>. \$150 of this is non-refundable – only 1 week before 1<sup>st</sup> day of class.
- Deposit of \$1,500 and must retain no less than \$500 in account for duration of training – all unused funds will be refunded at the end of training.

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### Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Regulations

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Under TSA regulations U.S. students training for their first aviation rating, or an instrument rating, are required to prove their citizenship status before we can commence flight training. Please make sure you bring with you the following:

- U.S. Passport; or
- Original U.S. birth certificate and a government issued picture identification (driver's license); or
- Original U.S. naturalization certificate with raised seal, USCIS or INS form N-550 or N-570 (Certificate of Naturalization) and a government issued picture identification (driver's license)

**NOTE:** If you are a U.S. permanent resident, but not a U.S. citizen please contact USATS as an additional TSA procedure must be followed.

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<sup>1</sup> If you are taking the Professional Pilot Program you will need a Class 2 Medical.

<sup>2</sup> Payment can be made by check or credit card. Credit card payment requires a signed authorization form.
