The Philosophy of OTIUM and Lo Shu

This square, known as the Lo Shu magic square, contains nine boxes, each filled with a number from 1 to 9. Remarkably, the sum of the numbers in every row, column and diagonal is always 15.

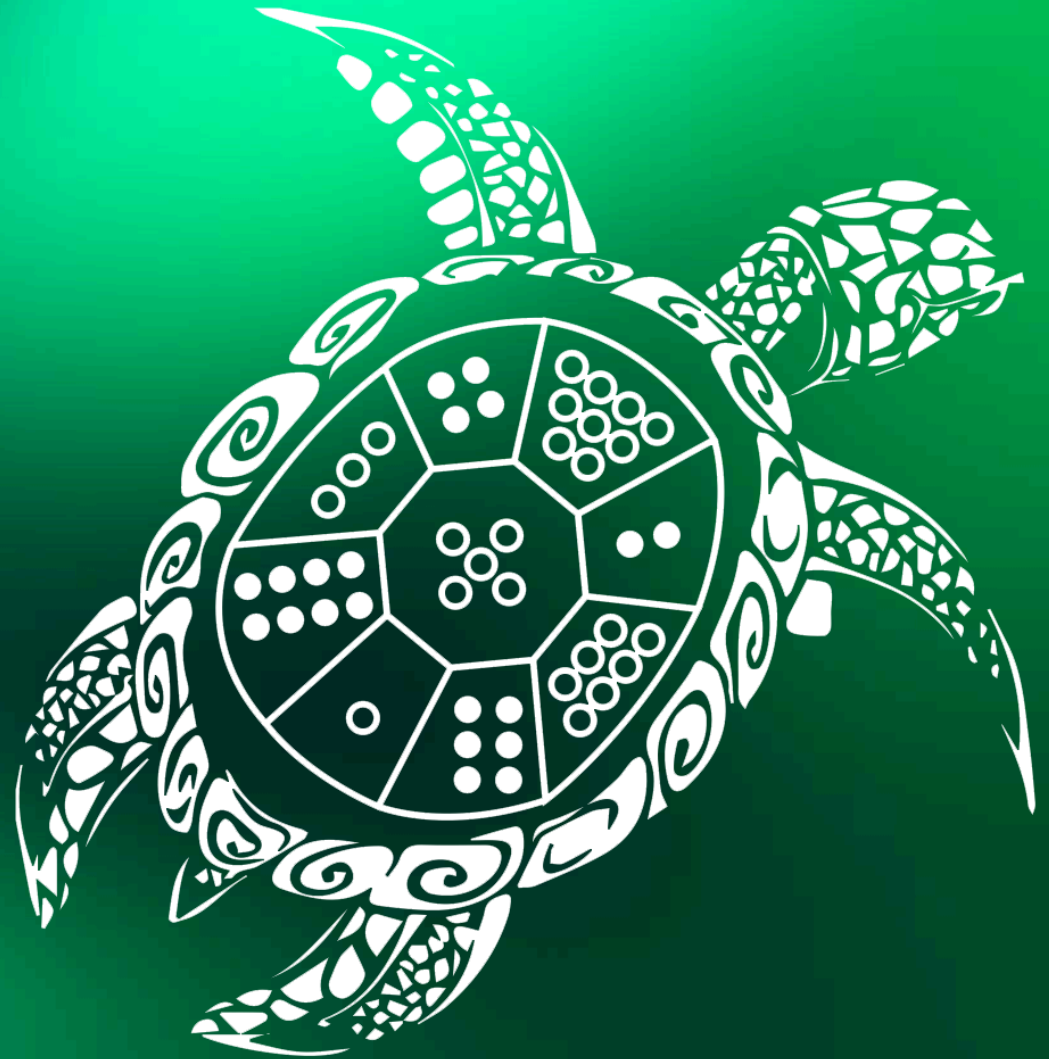
The discovery of this magical arrangement of numbers held great significance in Chinese culture. It was believed to possess extraordinary powers and became integral to various practices such as Feng Shui and Chinese astrology. Furthermore, titanium's natural silver color represents purity and simplicity, reflecting the minimalist and balanced approach of the OTIUM philosophy. Its neutral color complements a wide range of styles and colors, making it the perfect timepiece for all occasions.

OTIUM's rare precious metal collections provide durability, beauty, exotic dials, craftsmanship and even more rarity to the OTIUM wearer.

Dial

The dial of our watch is a visual representation of our brand values which reflects the concept of balance and harmony, with each layer representing different aspects of time and space and is inspired by the Lo Shu turtle and magic square patterns as they represent the flow of energy throughout the natural world. This unique dial is made from four layers, each representing a different aspect of OTIUM. Made from four distinct layers, it symbolizes the multifaceted nature of life and the different layers of meaning that can be derived from the passage of time.

The first layer is the base, which symbolizes the foundation of OTIUM: taking time to slow down and appreciate life. The second layer is the hour markers, which represent the passage of time and the importance of cherishing each moment. The third layer is the hands, which point towards the future and remind us to always be moving forward. And finally, the fourth layer is the date display, which serves as a reminder to take stock of our accomplishments and appreciate the progress we've made.

Terms & Conditions for Direct Sales

The following pages provide you with our Terms & Conditions (the "T&C") applicable to each and every sale of our watches via our website (www.otium.swiss).

If you have any questions concerning these T&C or our website please write to OTIUM by e-mail using the following address: support@montres-otium.com. All rights not expressly granted in these T&C are expressly reserved by OTIUM.

1. Your Contract with Us

These T&C apply to all services, orders and dispatches of OTIUM branded watches, that you, as the client, order from Montres Otium SA, a Swiss company limited by shares with its registered office at Pré-du-Pont 54, 2075 Thielle, the seller ("OTIUM"), via its website www.otium.swiss. In placing an order, you acknowledge that you have read, understood and accepted these T&C without reservation. Sales concluded through third parties (such as authorized retailers and or agents) are not subject to these T&C.

OTIUM reserves the right to amend these T&C at any time by publishing a new version on its website at <https://montres-otium.com/policies/terms-of-service>. Any order or product delivery to the client occurring after the publication of a new version of the T&C on the website shall be construed as acceptance thereof.

2. Purchasing eligibility

Only individuals (and not legal entities) who:

1. have reached the age of legal majority required to enter into contracts (eighteen in most countries)
2. have legal capacity to enter into contracts
3. use a shipping address in a country that we ship to,

may order products through our website. If you are under the age of legal majority or otherwise cannot lawfully enter into a contract, you must have your parent or guardian place an order on your behalf and they will be asked to agree to these T&C.

By placing an order through our website you represent and warrant that you are an end-user customer purchasing for your own or another's personal use and will not deliver, sell or otherwise distribute our products or purchase our products or services for commercial purposes.

3. Placing an order

To order your watch, a deposit of CHF 500 is required to confirm your order.

As soon as your deposit is received, we will send you an advance payment receipt and an order confirmation. It is your responsibility to review the order confirmation. If you have any questions or concerns or if an order confirmation does not reflect your intentions, you should contact us at support@montres-otium.com without delay.

The number of your watch (within the given range of the limited quantity of the series, for instance between 1 and 150) can be freely chosen after we received your deposit of 500 CHF.

Within 6 months of the Order Confirmation Date and at least 3 months before your manufacturing date we will inform you about the tentative manufacturing date that we have allocated to your order. Your manufacturing date is the date we proceed to the final encasing of your watch. It will be stated in your timepiece papers (the papers delivered with the watch, to prove its authenticity, record services and repairs as well as the warranty). Once this operation is completed, your watch will be tested for several weeks. Therefore, you can expect a delivery 3 to 4 weeks after your manufacturing date.

Should you change your mind and cancel your order within 14 days, we will refund the full amount (minus inherent banking and/or third party payment fees).

To cancel your order, you must contact us at support@montres-otium.com.

One week before the delivery of your timepiece, we will send you your final invoice, which has to be paid before delivery of your watch.

We try our best to respect your manufacturing date but delays sometimes occur due to circumstances outside our control. A delay of 6 months or more with respect to the tentative manufacturing date does not entitle to a refund without penalty. Should you request a cancellation during this period, the full deposit minus inherent banking and/or third party payment will be refunded.

All orders made through our website that have been manufactured but not been fully paid and/or collected three months after the manufacturing date can be sold to another customer. No refund can then be claimed.

4. Product availability and order acceptance

We reserve the right to refuse or cancel an order in case of serious doubts about the customer's compliance with these T&C or in case of arrears.

All orders placed through our Direct Sales Channel(s) are subject to availability and acceptance of such orders by us. Quantity limits may apply in relation to orders for certain products. We reserve the right to refuse at any moment in time, without prior notice, orders exceeding a certain number of products.

5. Prices, Taxes & Duties

All prices displayed on our website, in any OTIUM document or in any communication support (such as e-mail, WhatsApp messages, phone, etc.) are not contractual and can be modified at any time. Only quotes or order acknowledgements (order confirmation) issued by OTIUM are contractual. The relevant prices are our international prices in CHF and do not include any taxes or other fees.

Please note that changes to applicable law between the date your order is placed and the date you are sent a written quote or an order confirmation may result in changes to the taxes associated with your order. If the resulting change is an increase in the taxes that you are charged, we will contact you and ask that you to reconfirm your order. In case your purchase is delivered in another country than Switzerland, you might be requested by your country's customs authorities to pay local VAT and/or other taxes and duties before delivery can occur.

This is usually collected by our carrier during the importation process but can also be collected by your country's authorities.

8.1% Swiss VAT is applied and added to all purchases made in Switzerland.

If you are not a Swiss resident and are buying/picking up your purchase in Switzerland, you can claim for a full VAT refund on leaving the country. This tax refund will be made by OTIUM only after Swiss customs have checked, approved and returned to OTIUM your tax refund documents. Failure to comply with this process will result in the loss of your tax refund rights.

The declaration of your purchases made in Switzerland to your country of residence customs authorities is your sole responsibility.

6. Deliveries

In order to organize delivery, we will contact you as soon as your watch is ready.

Please take into account that OTIUM reserves the right, at its discretion, to refuse an order, in particular when our watches may not be sent to a specific country due to logistic or legal reasons. We only send products to the following countries or regions:

If you order several products, we will ship the order only once all products are available (there will be no partial shipments unless otherwise communicated to you).

7. Returns and warranty

We do not offer returns, exchanges or refunds for products purchased via our website. This does not affect your consumer rights in respect of defective products.

We are committed to ensuring that each product strictly complies with our quality criteria and that it has passed all our controls, both technical and aesthetic.

Products are covered by the applicable OTIUM warranty: All OTIUM timepieces, sold through retail partners or directly, come with a +5-year international lifelong warranty. As long as you have your timepiece serviced at least every 5 years by one of our authorized service centers your warranty is extended by a further 5 years.

8. Liability

We cannot guarantee the absence of any disruption in the operation of our website. 9. Applicable law

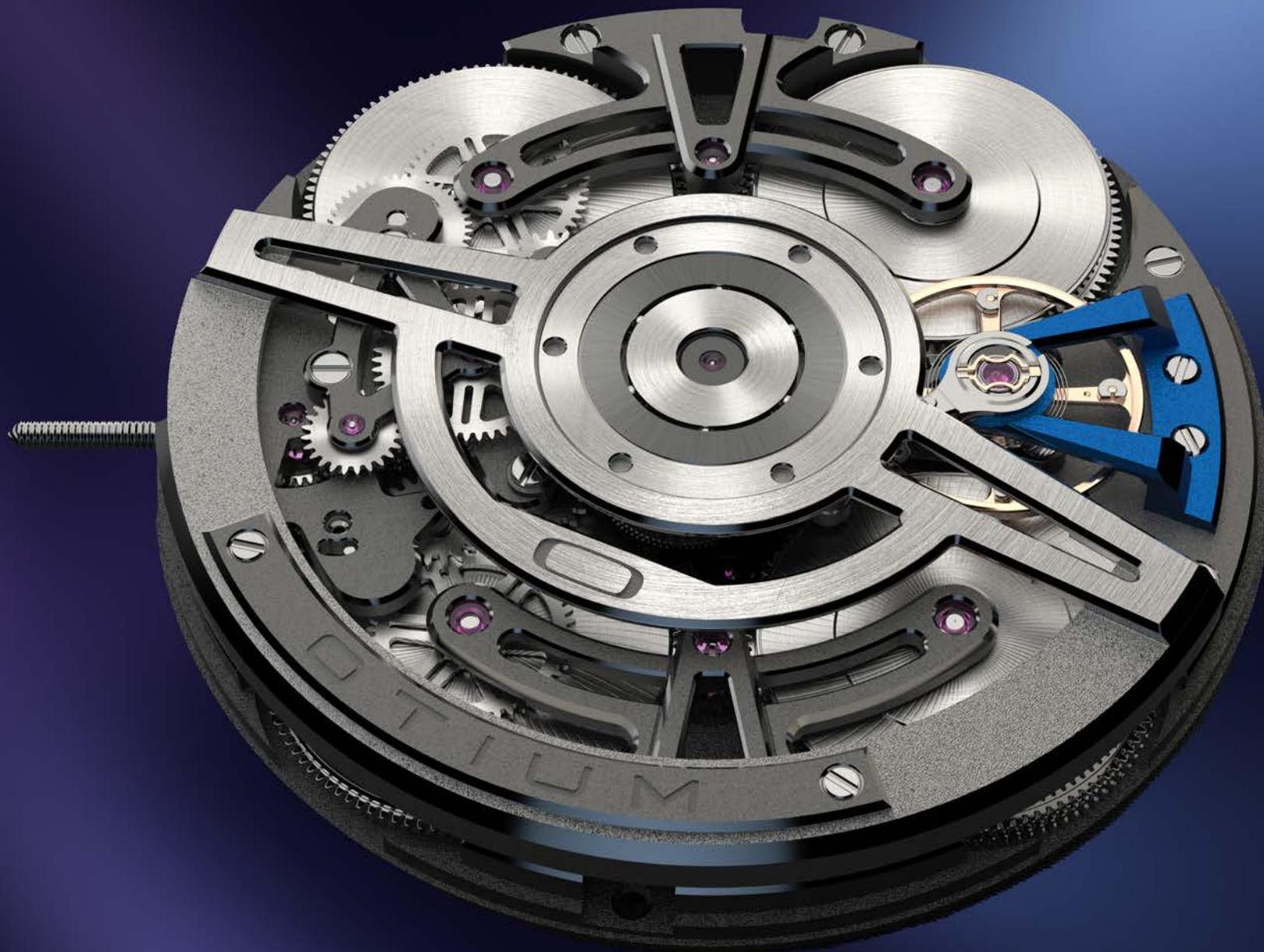
