1. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Daray Illumin8 SL250 is a powerful minor-surgery light which is available in wall or ceiling-mount versions.

The SL250 is for use during minor procedures, although it is also suitable for some major work. Each of the light heads uses a sophisticated reflector to produce a 'clean' light patch with virtually no heat in the beam. A filter in each head enhances the reflector's performance to bring the light output colour closer to that of natural daylight to ensure the colour of flesh tones is not distorted. A polycarbonate diffuser gives good shadow reduction whilst protecting the light head's components.

Overall, the light head cluster gives outstanding shadow reduction because each of the 3 heads acts as an independent source and each head has excellent shadow-reduction properties in its own right.

The 3 heads swivel, controlled by a removable, autoclavable twist handle mounted in the centre of the cluster, whilst a second, removable handle is also provided to assist with steering the light beam. The light is controlled from a wall-mounted module containing on/off and intensity controls.

The light assembly comprises 6 parts: a ceiling-mounting plate, a mains-voltage transformer which mounts on the plate, a down tube with top and bottom fittings, the wall-mounted control module, a suspension arm, and the light-head cluster.

The control module carries double fusing, a mains-isolator switch and a light switch with output variable-intensity control


The serial number is located on the central boss of the light-head cluster.


This label is located on the control module, next to the mains supply inlet.

3. INSTALLATION


CAUTION: this product must be earthed.





1. Fit the power-supply transformer to the mounting plate.




2. Fix the ceiling-mount plate to the ceiling slab using the 4 expansion bolts:




- 3. Fit the control module to the wall and arrange a mains-electrical feed to it via an isolating spur.
- 4. Arrange for a 1.5mm² 2+1 mains feed from the control module to the transformer on the ceiling mounting. The feed should be connected to the terminal block in the control module, with the live going to the dimmer output, and the CPC to the earthing point.



 At the transformer end, 230V mains must be connected to terminals '0' (neutral) and '110' (live), with a link



Connect the CPC to one of the set screws on the ceiling-mount plate. Remove the lower fitting from the fitted as supplied between terminals '0' and '110'.




7. If necessary, cut the down tube such that its bottom end is 2.25m above the floor when the tube is fitted to the ceiling-mounting plate.

If there is a false ceiling, cut a hole in it for the down tube to pass through and remove the collar from the down tube:



9. Insert a 'pull through' through the down tube:




11. If there is a false ceiling, fit the cover and collar:

down tube:




8. If necessary, drill 6xM6 clearance holes in the end of the down tube to take the bottom fitting.



10. Fit the down tube to the ceilingmounting plate:


Ensure the down tube is vertical in both axes by adjusting the nuts. Fit and tighten the locking nuts.



12. Feed the 'pull through' through the bottom fitting and rebolt the fitting to the down tube:


CAUTION: ensure the bottom fitting is orientated so the light's suspension arm will swing unimpeded through the required arc.

CAUTION: this is a 2-person job!




13. Lightly grease the end fitting where the suspension arm fits.

Use the 'pull through' to pull the arm low-voltage flex through the bottom fitting, down tube and top fitting, and slot the arm onto the bottom fitting:




14. Leaving the flex as short as practical, connect the low-voltage flex to the transformer terminals '0' and '25'.



15. Fit the light head: Remove the locking-ring clamp




16. Remove the locking ring



17. Slide on the safety collar and hold it temporarily in place with the grub screw.




18. Slide the head connector fully into the arm sleeve



19. Refit the locking ring and its clamp





20. Reposition the safety collar over the clamp and tighten the grub screws.

21. Remove the arm-locking plate from the underside of the arm

CAUTION: do not remove this plate before fitting the light head to the arm.

Provide power to the light and test it, ensuring all the features identified in 'Operation', below work correctly.

4. OPERATION


CAUTION: do not remove the control module front cover whilst the mains supply is connected. There are no user serviceable items inside the Module; if you experience mains-related problems with the light, you should refer them to a qualified electrician.

Turn the unit on by pressing the intensity control module.

Set the required illumination level by rotating the variable intensity control.

If the light does not illuminate, check the fuses.

Any other fault investigatory work should be undertaken by only a qualified electrician.



The light's patch size is adjusted by rotating the steering handle in the centre of the cluster.

The handle is removed for sterilising in an autoclave by pressing the button on its base and pulling it free

The second steering handle may be unscrewed for sterilising

5. MAINTENANCE

WARNING: do not use strong chemical cleaning agents such as 'Dettox' to sterilise the light. Do not use any abrasive materials to clean the light.


CAUTION: the light is not waterproof, so do not use excessive cleaning fluid amounts.

- 1. Suitably protect hands.
- 2. Wipe the light using clean tissue or soft towelling.
- 3. Apply to all surfaces a 1% solution of sodium hypochlorite using a soft cloth.
- 4. Within 10 minutes, remove the chemical from all surfaces using a damp, soft cloth. The chemical will cause corrosion of metal parts, if it is not thoroughly removed.
- 5. Apply isopropanol to the surfaces this is an alcohol-based fluid which evaporates without leaving any residue and can be obtained as an impregnated-cloth applicator.


6. LAMP REPLACEMENT

TURN OFF the mains power.

CAUTION: use only LB4059 replacement lamps from Daray. These are special lamps and the use of any other type would seriously impair the performance of your light.



Remove the diffuser by undoing the 4 crosshead screws



Remove the glass filter by carefully moving back 3 of the metal lugs.

Gently move the lamp shield to one side

The shield can be refitted, if it comes out of its retaining groove, by squeezing the 2 sides of the wire holder.

Remove the blown lamp by moving it from side to side and pulling it directly out of its holder. CAUTION: the lamp may be very hot!

Holding a replacement lamp by its plastic packaging, insert the wire connectors into the lamp holder. CAUTION: do not touch the lamp quartz envelope with your fingers.

Refit the lamp shield, filter and diffuser.

7. FUSE REPLACEMENT

CAUTION: fuses normally blow for a reason. Investigate likely faults before changing fuses. CAUTION: isolate the unit from the mains before accessing the fuses.

Both the live and neutral mains inputs are fused. The fuses are contained in holders on the front panel of the control module; the fuse carrier unscrews from the holder

8. SPARE PARTS

CAUTION: Use only genuine 'Daray' replacement lamps as other types may seriously impair the optical performance of the product.

If you send us goods that do not qualify for return, you will invalidate your claim to any refund, and you will be obliged to compensate DARAY Ltd for the cost of return postage and any other reasonable costs incurred processing the goods.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF WARRANTY

- To qualify for this warranty you must register on www.daray.co.uk or return to Daray Ltd (Daray) the duly completed warranty-registration form accompanying the product.
- 2. Daray warrants this product (excluding lamp) against faulty material and workmanship during the period of the warranty. The period of warranty is the period stated on your warranty card and commences on the date of purchase of the product. In the event that the product is not in good working order Daray will provide, during the warranty period, a free repair service within the United Kingdom. The warranty is subject to proof of purchase being provided; therefore, you should retain your original receipt.
 - 2.1 The repair service consists of the provision of spare parts and/or replacement products (at Daray's discretion) which will be provided on an exchange basis and will either be new, equivalent to new or reconditioned. All replaced spare parts and products shall become the property of Daray.
 - 2.2 Daray's only obligation under this warranty is the provision of the service as set out above.
