I'm ready to fly my drone. Do I **NEED** a Remote Pilot Certification?

The rules can get tricky! If you're not sure, a Part 107 prep course should be on your horizon.

A Part 107 prep course provides valuable training for any Drone Educator. However, the course and the FAA Remote Pilot Certification that it prepares you for are not strictly required in every educational circumstance.

To see if you need an FAA Remote Pilot Certification or if you would benefit from a Part 107 prep course, work through the flowchart below.



Pilots flying under The Exception for Recreational Pilots are not required to earn their FAA Remote Pilot Certification.

A Part 107 course may not be required, but it does hold valuable knowledge for you and the pilots around you!
