## **How to Use Grain Filler**

**Description:** Thixotropic grain filler based on oil based resins, extenders

and suitably coloured.

**Uses:** To choke or fill the grain before polishing or lacquering to

achieve a "full finish"

Colour range: Transparent (neutral) , Light oak, Dark (brown) Mahog-

any, Black.

**Drying Time:** The grain filler should preferably be left overnight to dry or

a minimum of 4 hours.

**Method:** Apply with coarse cloth i.e. Curtaining or

Hessian in a circular motion, finishing off across the grain. Leave until the 'wet look' has gone then wipe off across the grain with a clean coarse cloth to remove the excess. Leave to dry overnight and paper with 150-180 grit sand-

paper.

**Finishing:** It will except most stains and can be finished with most

types of lacquers and polishes.
