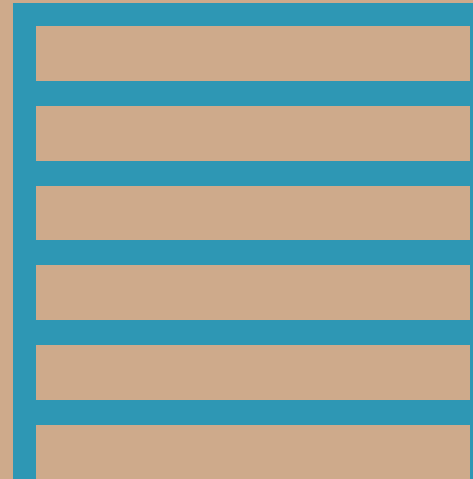

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BEFORE ASSEMBLING YOUR SHUTTER WALL

Please read all the instructions carefully before you begin, and follow the steps in the order they are presented.

Make sure you have all the tools required for assembling your shutter wall

In order to assemble your shutter wall safely and correctly, please ensure you have access to the following tools and accessories, all of which are not provided.



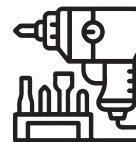

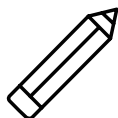

Check to ensure there are no missing parts:






Before you begin assembly, please check that you have all the parts required to assemble your shutter wall. Please also carefully check that the quantity of parts match with that of the model you have purchased.

If any parts are missing, please refer **Warranty & Complaints Procedure** to contact customer service before beginning the assembly.

Prepare the parts you will need for each step:

In the **Assembly** section of the manual, each step indicates the necessary parts and quantities required to complete the step. We recommend that you prepare the parts you will need for each assembly step. Doing this will save you time and effort during assembly. If possible, place the parts on cardboard or other soft surface to protect from scratching the painted surfaces.

Select a suitable location:

The ground should be solid and flat	The ground should be level	The shutter wall must be positioned and fixed on a properly installed Mirador pergola, which is installed on a flat concrete ground, providing proper stability.
		
		

Warning:

Most terraces or patios are designed with a slight slope to prevent (rain) water from forming pools or reaching the house or other structures. For the perfect shutter wall assembly, a level concrete surface without such a slope is required. Small pebbles could also prevent the shutter wall from being safely secured on the ground.

If the shutter wall is installed on an uneven surface, it may prevent accessory components from working correctly and may void the product warranty.









To prepare it, you need to:

- check for underground pipes and cables (Call 811 before you dig if you live in the USA)
- check with your local authorities regarding any building permits that may be required
- contact a reliable contractor to have concrete base if you don't have one





Do not assemble the shutter wall on sandy, muddy or loose soil, as the stakes do not have the sufficient anchorage to be installed in these types of soil.




IMPORTANT SAFETY ADVICE

For the safety of all persons assembling and using the shutter wall, it is important to follow the safety guidelines below.








<p>It is recommended that two people lift the shutter wall once assembled. Ensure you lift with the correct posture & technique.</p>	<p>Always wear appropriate work shoes, gloves and eye protection when working.</p>	<p>Work well away from power lines, particularly when handling metal parts.</p>	<p>If using power tools or a ladder, always follow the manufacturer's safety instructions.</p>
			
<p>Make sure the shutter wall complies with local building regulatory codes.</p>	<p>Working at heights can be dangerous. Always wear protective clothing to prevent injury in the event of a fall.</p>	<p>Only use ladders and scaffolding with a sufficiently high load bearing capacity.</p>	<p>Be careful not to get clothing or body parts caught in the shutter wall when they are in motion.</p>
			

<p>Do not assemble the shutter wall when you find damaged parts or any parts missing. Only use replacement parts that are approved by the manufacturer.</p>	<p>Please recycle packaging where possible.</p>	<p>After prolonged use we recommend you check all the fittings are tightened securely.</p>	<p>Install on non-Mirador branded pergola will void the product warranty and can damage the operation mechanism.</p>

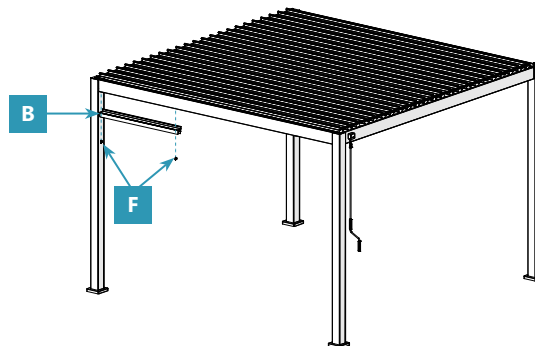
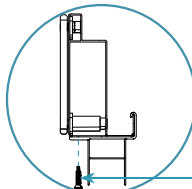
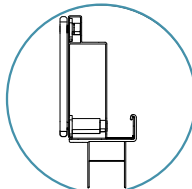
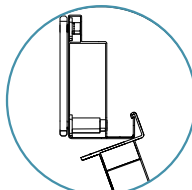
Hang the top track **B** over the beam (against the pergola pillar or in the center).

Fasten top track **B** to beam with 2 screws **F**, using electric screwdriver.

Sectional view



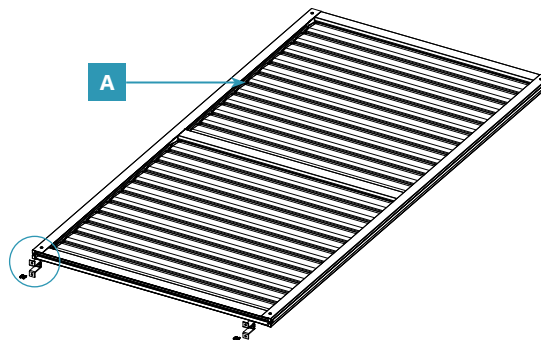
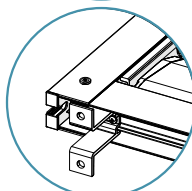
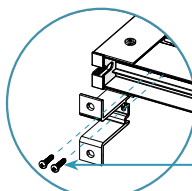

Assemble the foot pads **C** to the bottom of the shutter wall **A** with 4 screws **G** clockwise. Using electric screwdriver.

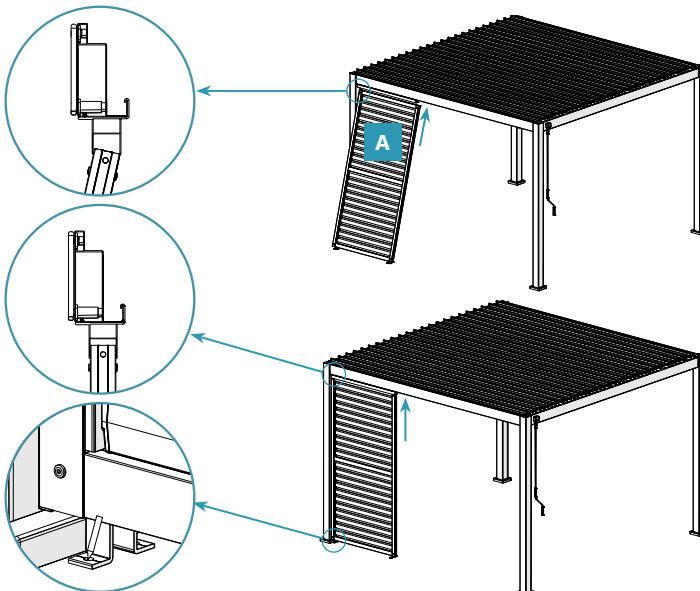

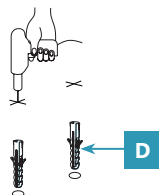
Lift shutter wall **A** up into the top track **B**, make sure the shutter wall is perpendicular to the ground. Mark the position of the drill holes on the ground with pencil.

Remove the wall, drill holes with hammer drill and knock in the plastic expansion pipe **D** with hammer.

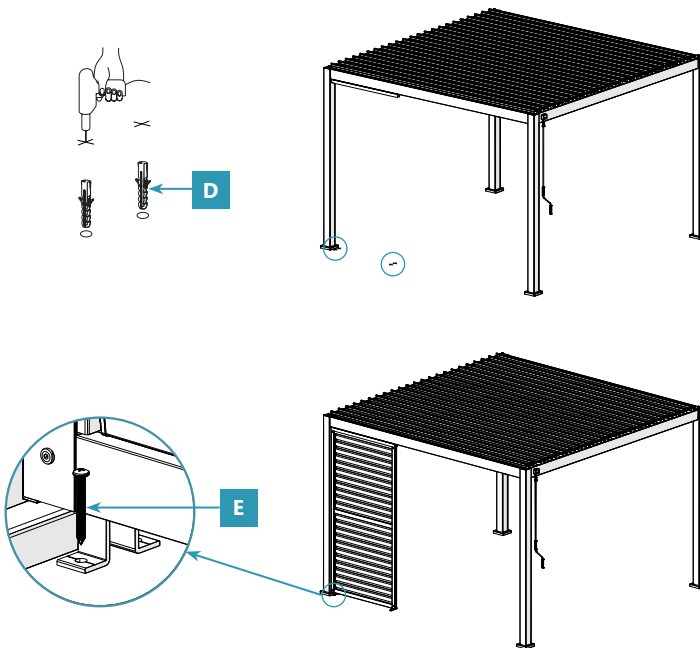

Fix the shutter wall to the ground with screw **E**, using electric screwdriver.

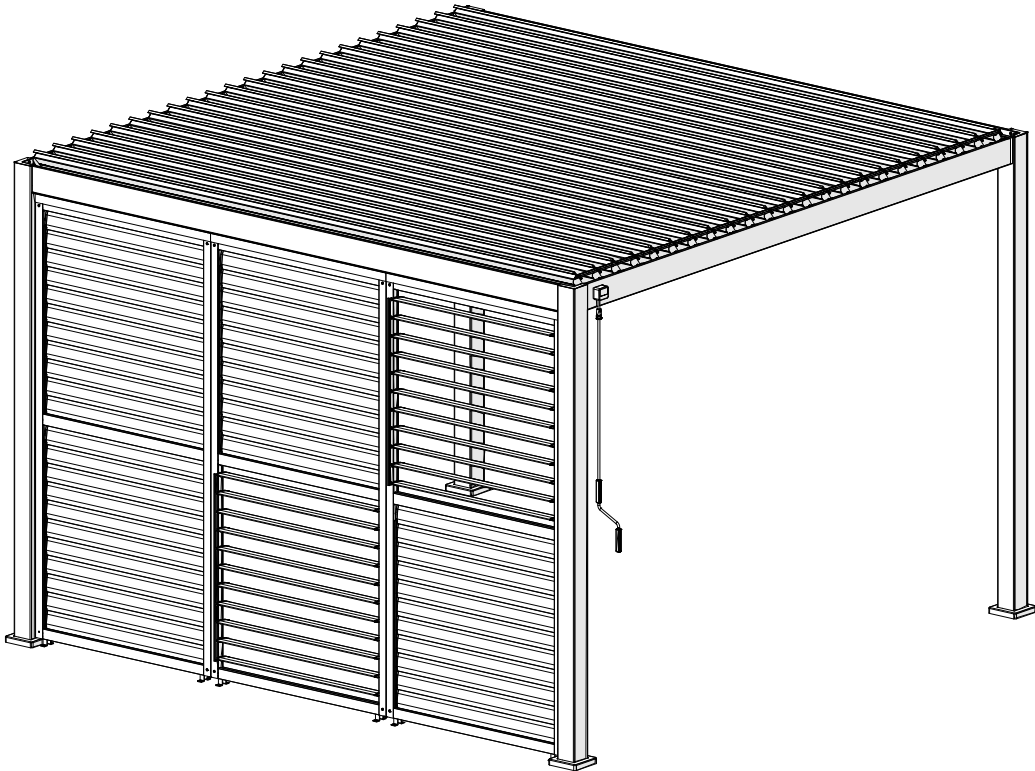
Notice: Always start from the left / right hand side shutter wall if it is intended to assemble more than 1 shutter wall on one side of the pergola. Repeat steps

1 - 5 to assemble the other shutter walls.









ENJOY YOUR SHUTTER WALL



The louvers on the upper and lower sections of each door can be individually adjusted to meet your personal preferences.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

<p>Dust and dirt will collect on the shutter wall and will require periodic cleaning.</p>	<p>Use a water/detergent mixture and a soft clean cloth to clean the shutter wall.</p>	<p>Air dry or wipe with a soft clean cloth.</p>
		
<p>In coastal areas, it is recommended that you frequently spray the shutter wall with water to reduce accumulation of salt and dirt.</p>	<p>From more soiled areas, rinse the surface with clean water from top to bottom.</p>	<p>Do not use any acidic, alkaline or petroleum based spray lubricants.</p>
		

* Alcohol based cleaner: methyl alcohol, ethyl alcohol, butyl alcohol, Isopropyl alcohol, etc.


