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BEFORE ASSEMBLING YOUR SLIDING DOORS

WARNING: Important safety instructions. Follow all instructions, since incorrect installation can lead to severe injury.

Make sure you have all the tools required for assembling your sliding doors

In order to assemble your sliding doors safely and correctly, please ensure you have access to the following tools and accessories, all of which are not provided.

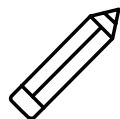

Check to ensure there are no missing parts:






Before you begin installation, please check that you have all the parts required to assemble your sliding doors. Please also carefully check that the quantity of parts match with that of the model you have purchased.

If any parts are missing, please refer **Warranty & Complaints Procedure** to contact customer service before beginning the installation.

Prepare the parts you will need for each step:

In the **Installation** section of the manual, each step indicates the necessary parts and quantities required to complete the step. We recommend that you prepare the parts you will need for each installation step. Doing this will save you time and effort during assembly. If possible, place the parts on cardboard or other soft surface to protect from scratching the painted surfaces.

Select a suitable location:

The ground should be solid and flat	The ground should be level	The sliding doors must be positioned and fixed on a properly installed Mirador pergola, which is installed on a flat concrete ground, providing proper stability.
		
		

Warning:

Most terraces or patios are designed with a slight slope to prevent (rain) water from forming pools or reaching the house or other structures. For the perfect sliding doors installation, a level concrete surface without such a slope is required. Small pebbles could also prevent the sliding doors from being safely secured on the ground.

If the sliding doors is installed on an uneven surface, it may prevent accessory components from working correctly and may void the product warranty.








To prepare it, you need to:













- check for underground pipes and cables (Call 811 before you dig if you live in the USA)
- check with your local authorities regarding any building permits that may be required
- contact a reliable contractor to have concrete base if you don't have one

Do not assemble the sliding doors on sandy, muddy or loose soil, as the stakes do not have the sufficient anchorage to be installed in these types of soil.












For the safety of all persons installing and using the sliding doors , it is important to follow the safety guidelines below.

<p>Open the sliding doors during severe weather conditions which include high winds.</p>	<p>Always wear appropriate work shoes, gloves and eye protection when working.</p>	<p>Work well away from power lines, particularly when handling metal parts.</p>	<p>If using power tools or a ladder, always follow the manufacturer's safety instructions.</p>
			
<p>Make sure the sliding doors complies with local building regulatory codes.</p>	<p>Working at heights can be dangerous. Always wear protective clothing to prevent injury in the event of a fall.</p>	<p>Only use ladders and scaffolding with a sufficiently high load bearing capacity.</p>	<p>Be careful not to get clothing or body parts caught in the sliding doors when they are in motion.</p>
			

<p>Do not assemble the sliding doors when you find damaged parts or any parts missing. Only use replacement parts that are approved by the manufacturer.</p>	<p>Please recycle packaging where possible.</p>	<p>After prolonged use we recommend you check all the fittings are tightened securely.</p>	<p>Install on non-Mirador branded pergola will void the product warranty and can damage the operation mechanism.</p>

<p>It is recommended that two people lift the top track once assembled. 1. Track and frame assembly

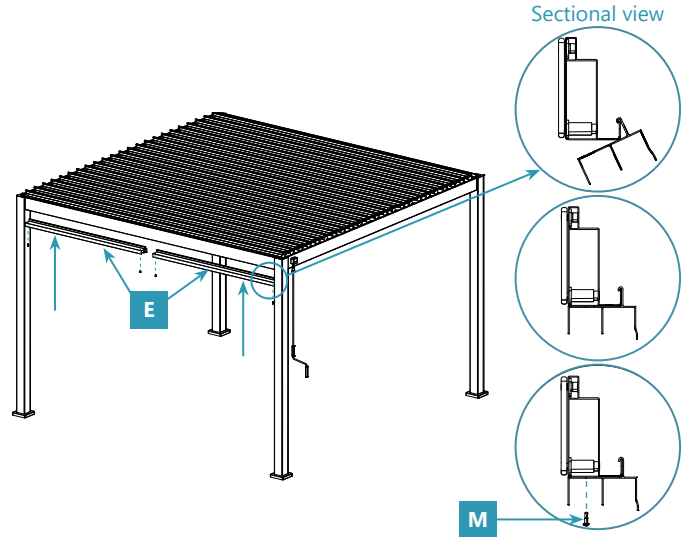

Hang the 2 top tracks **E** over the beam.
Fasten top track **E** to beam with 4 screws **M**, using electric screwdriver.

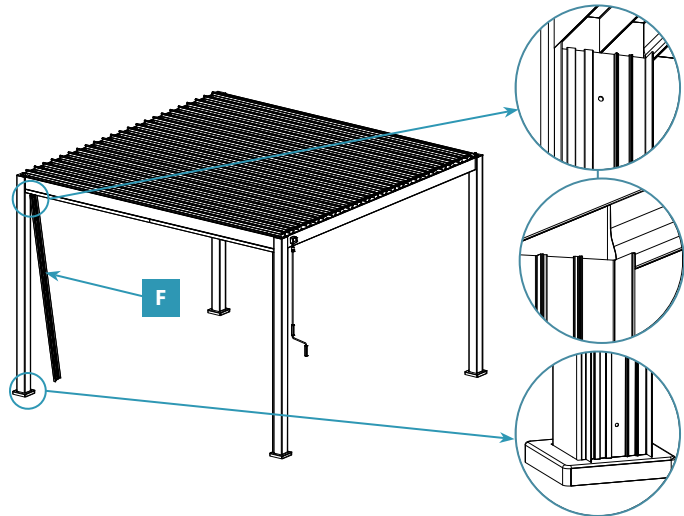

Position the side frame **F** to the pillar.
The side wall of the side frame **F** is attached to the inside of the top track **E**.

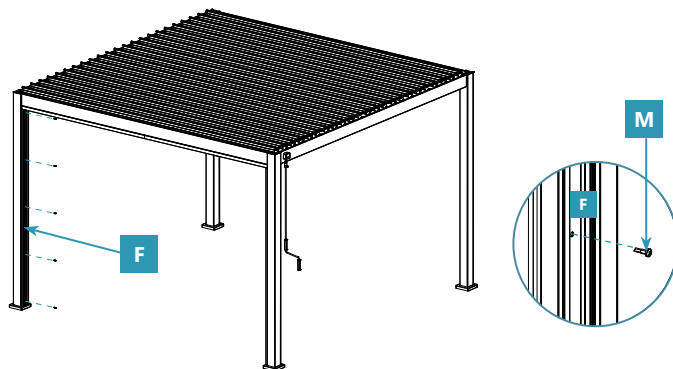

Fix the side frame **F** to the pillar with 5 screws **M** by using an electric screwdriver.

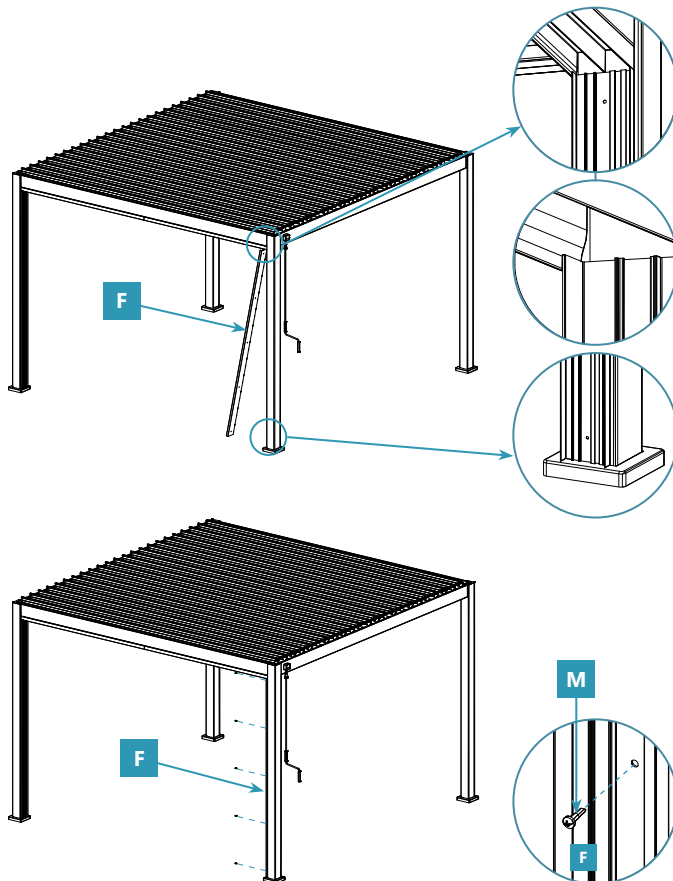

Repeat steps **1B** - **1C** to install the side frame **F** onto the other pillar.

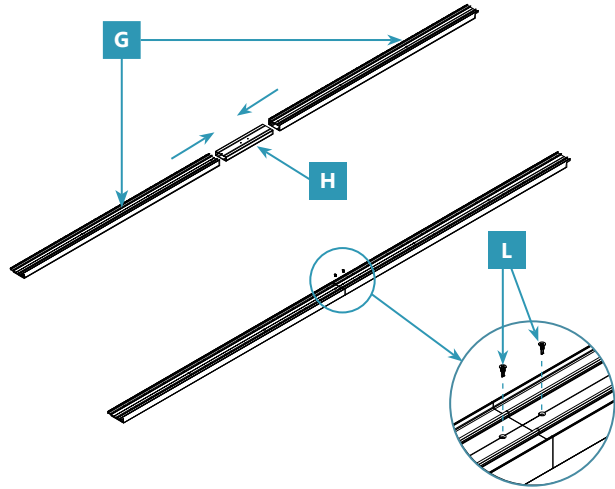
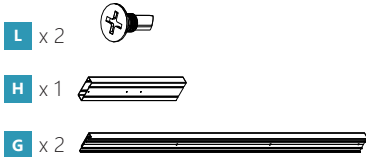

Slide 2 bottom tracks **G** into the connect pipe **H** until their ends meet. Make sure the screw holes on both **G** and **H** are aligned, and fix **G** and **H** together with 2 screws **L** by using an electric screwdriver.



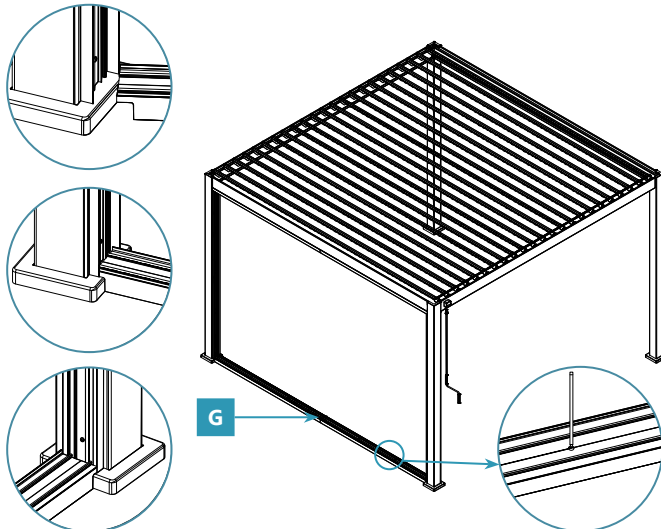

Position the bottom track **G** against the pergola pillars.

Notice:

The side wall of the bottom track **G** is attached to the inside of the side frame **F**.

Mark the position of the drill holes on the ground with pencil.

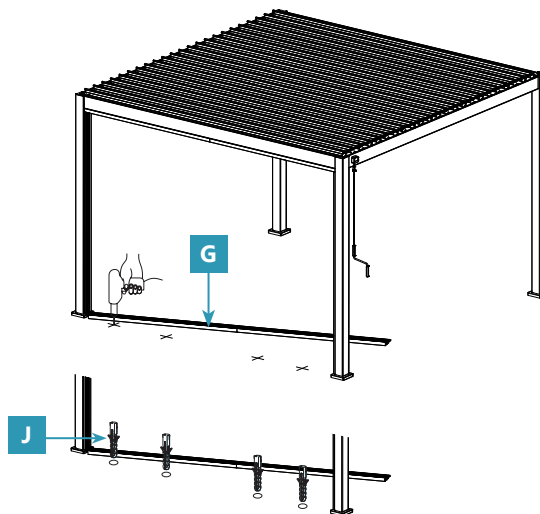

Remove the bottom track **G**, drill holes with hammer drill and knock in the plastic expansion pipe **J** with hammer.

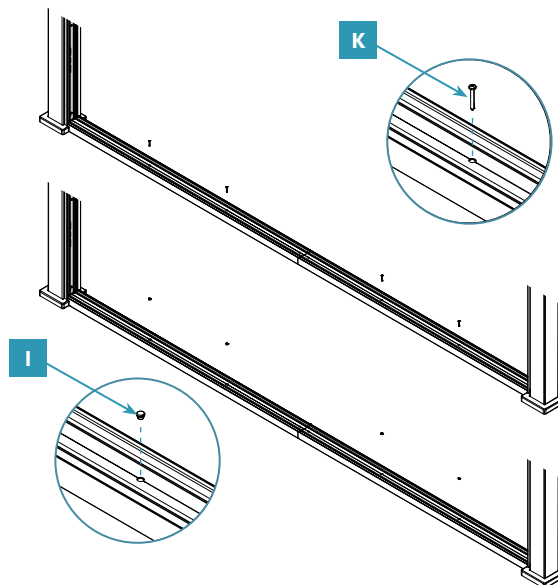

Put the bottom track **G** back to the position.
Fixed the bottom track **G** to the ground with 4 screws **K** and cover the screws with 4 screw caps **I**.

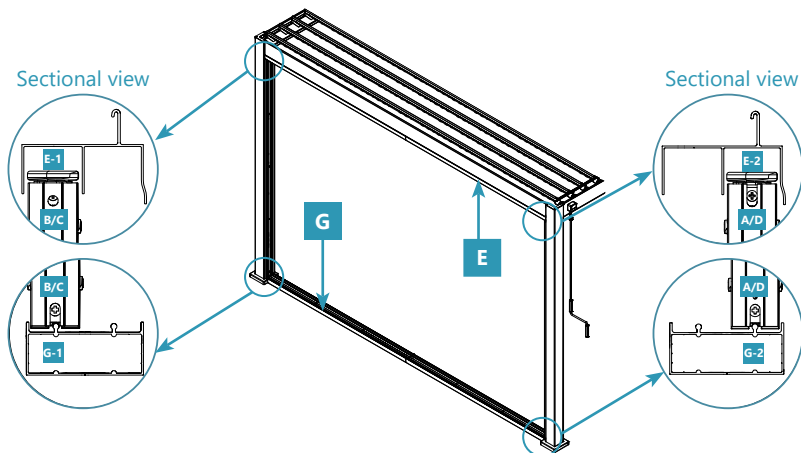
2. Door assembly

2A

Attention:

- Top track **E** and bottom track **G**.
- Each track has two slides.
- Sliding panels **B** and **C** are installed on the outer slides **E-1** / **G-1**.
- Sliding panels **A** and **D** are installed on the inner slides **E-2** / **G-2**.

Before installation, please ensure the correct positioning of the slides on the track and the orientation of the door lock.

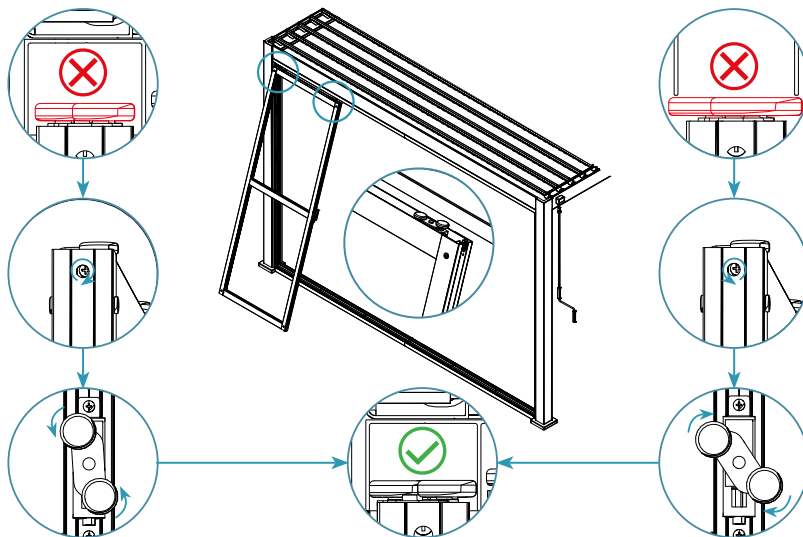

To ensure a perfect fit between the door and the track, please take the following steps:

If the rollers do not make contact with the track, rotate the screw clockwise.

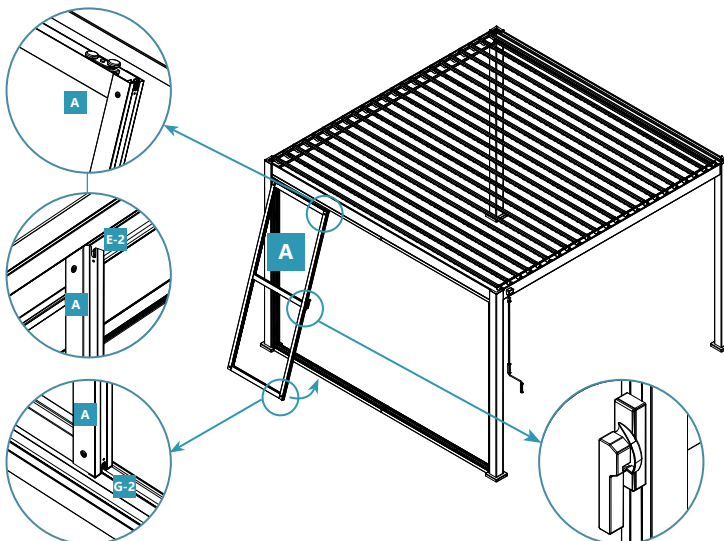
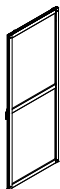
If the rollers cannot fit into the track, rotate the screws counterclockwise. Using a Philips screwdriver.

Lift sliding panel **A** up into the inner slide of the track **E-2**. Swing the bottom in and tuck the sliding panel down into the bottom track **G-2**. Please note the orientation of the lock side.

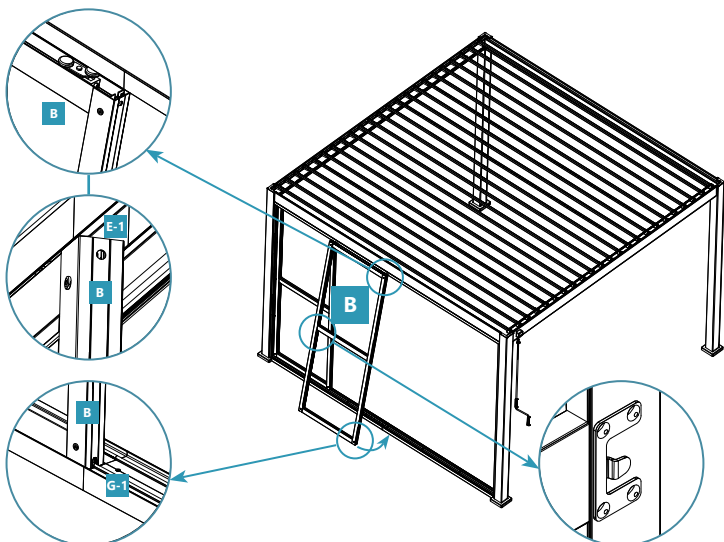
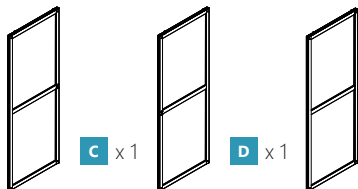

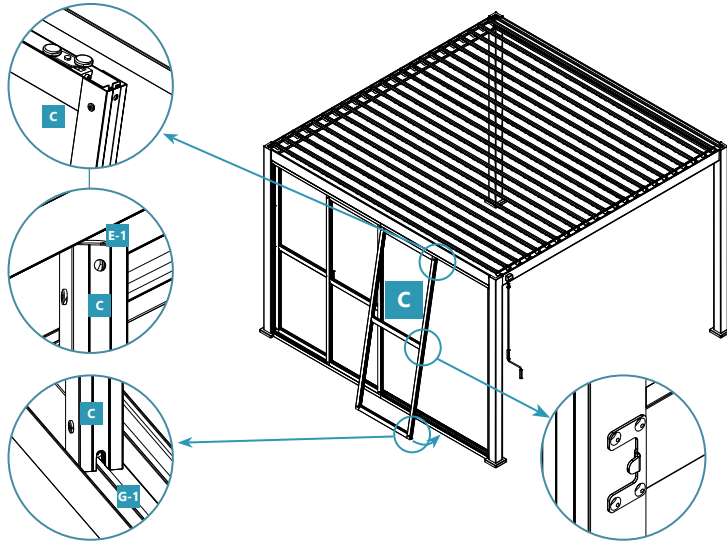
Repeat step **2C** to install the rest sliding panels.

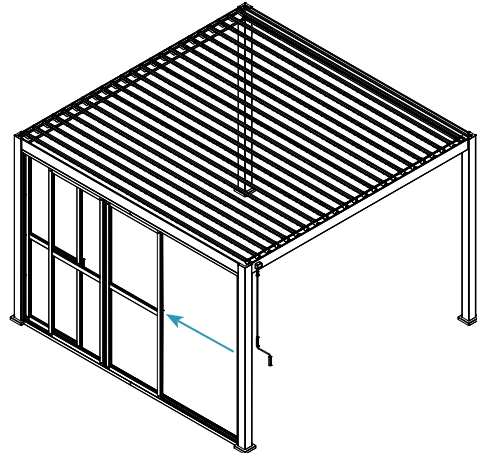

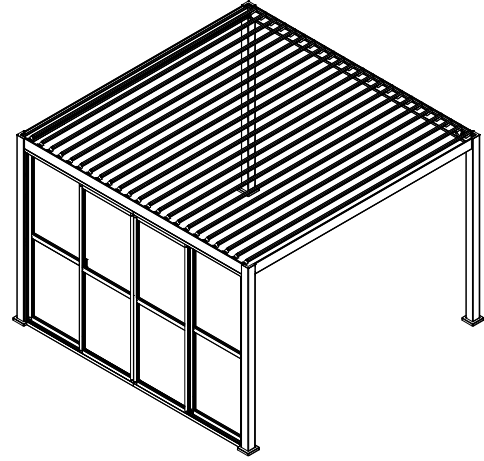
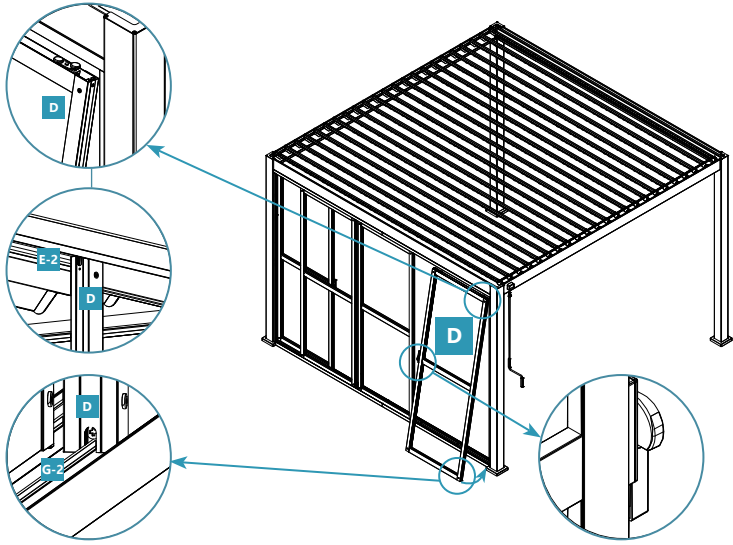




Attention:

3. Adjust your sliding doors

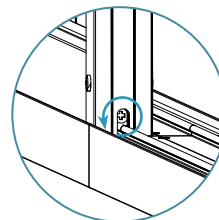
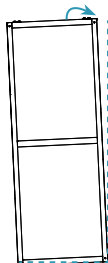
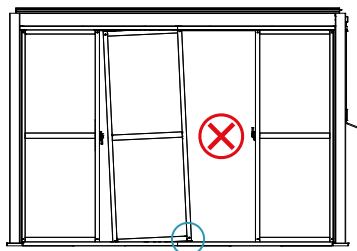
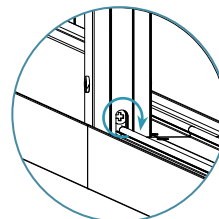
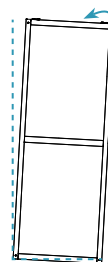
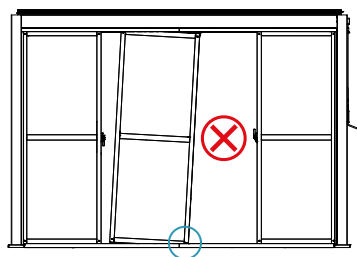
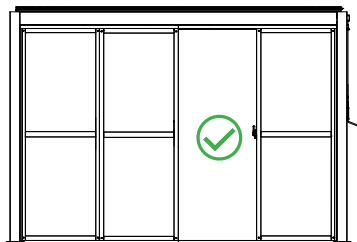

You'll find screws on both sides of the door near the bottom, which can be used to adjust the height of one side.

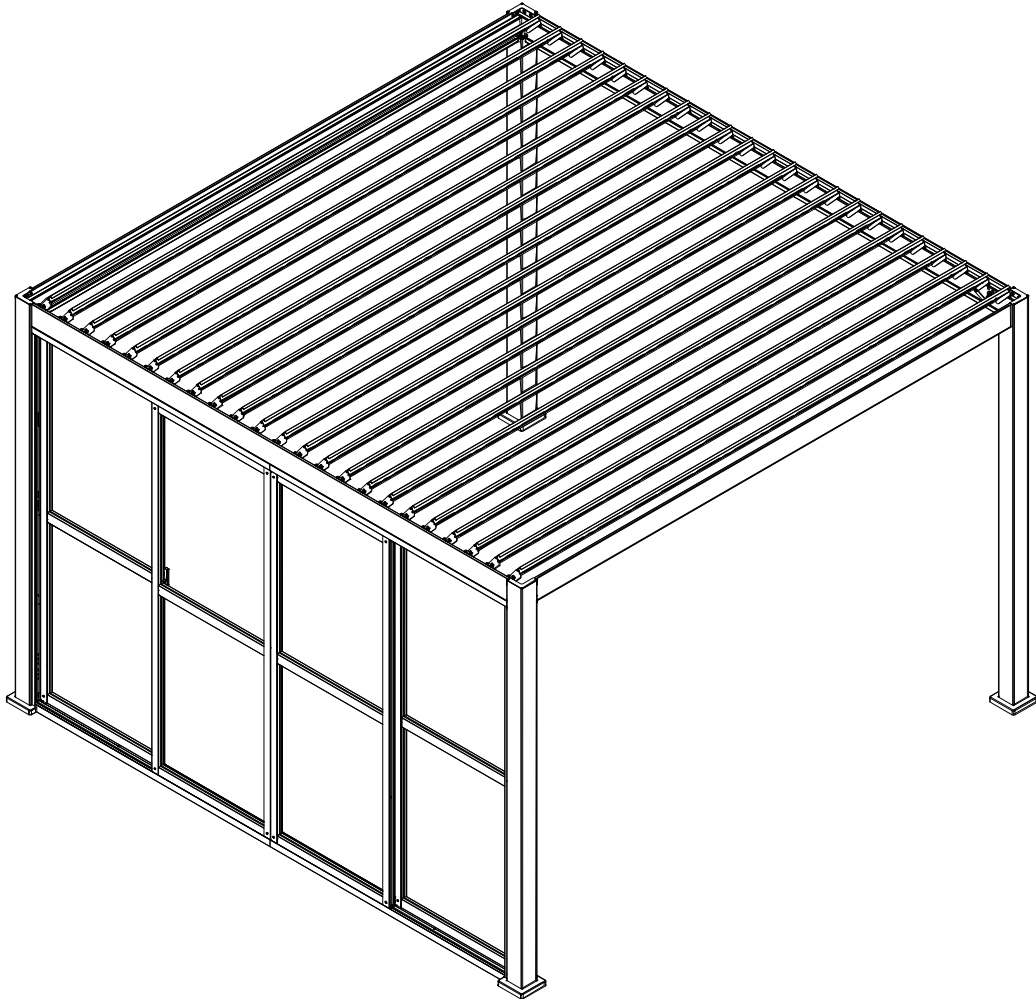
To raise that side, turn the screw clockwise.

To lower that side, turn the screw counterclockwise.

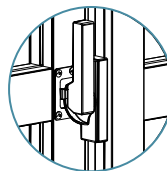


ENJOY YOUR SLIDING DOORS

Remove the inner (transparent) and outer (white) film on the sliding panels.



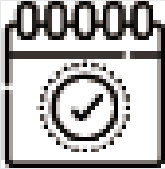

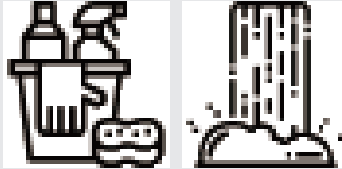

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Dust and dirt will collect on the PC panel and will require periodic cleaning by water, then air dry or wipe with 100% cotton cloth.



After gently wiping the stains on the PC panel with alcohol based cleaner *, rinse it clean with water.



Only use a soft clean cloth made by 100% cotton to clean or dry the PC panel.



In coastal areas, it is recommended that you frequently spray the screen with water to reduce accumulation of salt and dirt.



Always test cleaners in a small inconspicuous area prior to cleaning entire panel to prevent adverse results.



Never use acidic, alkaline, oleaginous or abrasive cleaners on the PC panel.



* Alcohol based cleaner: methyl alcohol, ethyl alcohol, butyl alcohol, Isopropyl alcohol, etc.


