

Smithson Projects presents *Linear Construction*, a contemporary group exhibition exploring abstraction, rhythm and repetition.

Linear Construction borrows its title from a 1936 ink drawing by Josef Albers in which one continuous fine line, with no apparent beginning or end reveals a three-dimensional shape that finds architectural poise in its composition. For Albers, his *Linear Construction* series made up of drawings and engravings, is concerned with the dynamic perception of space and form, and the plastic movement of lines, planes and volumes (Saletnik 2022).

The show brings together sixteen contemporary abstract artists, working across a variety of visual mediums, to present a curatorial meditation on artwork as an iterative process of linear construction. This collective articulation is as much about the linear elements, as it is the application of materials, the use of colour, and the sculptural elements of construction.

For curator Anna Smithson, colour, form, and abstraction lie at the heart of her aesthetic interests, and this show brings into conversation a range of artists who centre these concerns in bold, playful, and experimental ways, whilst embracing an enduring commitment to their material processes.



Diorama explores the narrative of scenes, vistas and architecture, playfully depicting construction while supporting decorative elements that allow wonder and imagination

Made from metal and glass, the materials are both complimentary and opposing. Collaborating on design, Amy Cushing & Lara Sparey have created pieces made from CNC laser cut steel, powder coated to create 3D platforms with sculptural details. Cushing's kiln-formed glass elements are hand crafted, entirely unique, and carefully curated to introduce striking colour and composition against the graphic backdrop.

These set of masks are elaborate patterns crafted in tiny chicken feet bones onto woven sinamay - a strong, organic fabric used for millinery. In Jamaica, where chicken feet are a delicacy - my Great Grandmother lived in the small fishing village of Saint Elizabeth and would weave grass hats for the fisherman, to make ends meet.

From far across the ocean, and a different era of time - I feel connected to her through this shared act of making. The repetition of form to create a (mock)textile - is very much inspired by Anni Albers and the story of her repeating objects on the floor with her students when the looms hadn't arrived yet for their weaving classes. This story teased open my constrained idea about textiles, into recognising a more abstract expression.'



























Boundary Estate, a suspended tableau, nods to the rich multicultural history of Shoreditch. In 1890 the area was one of the poorest in London when the Boundary Estate, an early example of social housing in Europe, was established. In the artwork, Rasul celebrates the diversity of the present-day Bangladeshi, Turkish and Jewish communities in contrast to the hyper-gentrification of the area, provoking an energy through patterns, multi-textile surfaces, bold bright colours and arbitrary lines. Rasul carefully researched the rich history of the area by talking to local community members and the Friends of Arnold Circus, as well as referring to archival maps and photographs held at Bishopsgate institute.

The cartographic 2D sculpture is a screenshot of time, designed to be suspended from the ceiling to facilitate a two-way viewing experience via the see-through net gauze. The translucent net acts as a metaphor for social change as you become a voyeur in the work, taking a journey through present-day Boundary Estate versus its history.
