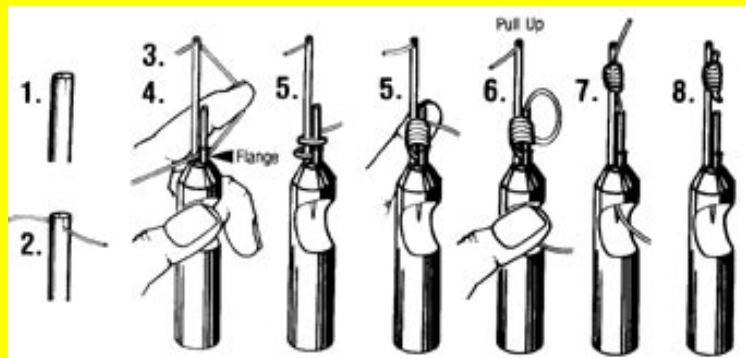

SLIP BOBBER KNOT TYING TOOL - 1152 through 1160

Caution: When working with any tool, wear safety glasses.



- 1) Use X-Acto knife to make a slit in one end of a straw approx. 1/8" long

- 2) Cut a 10" piece of slip bobber knot material. Insert one end in the slit in the straw

- 3) Slide end of straw without slit into hole in tool leaving 1-1/2" of straw above the black portion of the tool

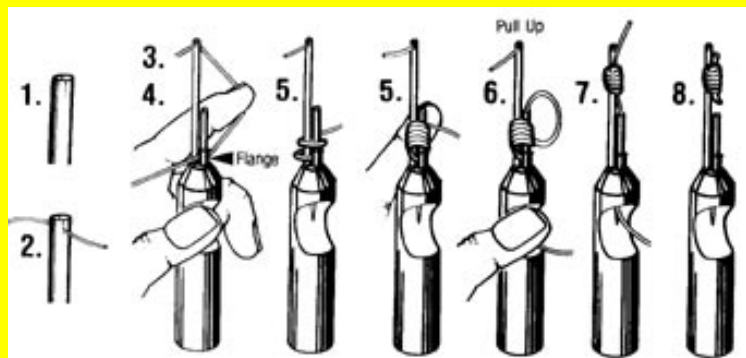
- 4) Holding tool in left hand (with straw facing away from you), extend index finger. Wrap knot material over index finger and snap between straw and black flange. Remove finger and pull long end of knot material until tight

- 5) Wrap knot material clockwise around straw and brass tube 4 to 6 times (on brass tube), holding knot material on straw with index finger

- 6) Push long end of knot material down hole in brass tube. Pull through until knot is tight. Hold line firmly with your thumb on the thumb slot. To remove knot, hold knot on straw and pull straw up out of tool

- 7) Leaving knot on plastic straw, take knot material out of slit in straw and trim trim excess line from knot leaving 3/4" on each side of knot

- 8) To make multiple knots on one straw, simply slide previous knot towards top of straw (end with slit), and return to step number 2
