- Use only in the positions indicated on the manual.
- Make sure the product is properly inflated with the air valve closed tightly.
- Do not use this product if it is damaged or leaking air.
- Do not exceed the manufacturer's recommended person capacity for this product.
- This is not a towable tube.
- Do not use this item as a baby or pet float.
- Do not use this item as a surfboard.
- Do not use this item as a fishing vessel.
- Store this item deflated and indoors in a cool, dry place.

- Always stay awake and aware when using this item.
- Do not swim underneath this unit at anytime.
- Monitor and adjust bladder pressure on warm days and in direct sunlight.
- Do not use this unit when it is under-inflated. The risks involved with this could include entrapment, which may result in death or serious injury.

- 0.2mm non-phthalate free PVC bladder
- 2 Safety Valves for easy Inflation and Deflation
- \* Please note the Maternity Surf Pool Lounger is not a surfboard and not a towable float.

**ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION:**

1. Locate the 2 valves on the each end of the pool lounge.
2. Inflate the float until it is firm and the cover is wrinkle free and taut. (Please see the INFLATION section below for proper inflation instruction).
3. Close valve completely.
4. Use electric air pump for faster inflation.
5. For specific instructions on how to use a particular valve, see the INFLATION section.

**USE:**

Once product is properly inflated this float can be used as air mattress on flat surface (e.g. floor) and in pools, very calm waters away from boats and other hazards. Follow the standard instructions to use the pool lounge:

1. Inflate fully both air chambers located at both ends of the lounge for use on water or on the floor by using an electric air pump (not included).



2. To get on safely, start by kneeling down on the float leg section.



3. Walk your hands forward to crawling position, with shoulders directly over wrists and hips directly over knees, then lower yourself down carefully.



4. Position your body with belly in the hole and ALWAYS ensure your hips are supported by the raised rim around the hole, to avoid any pressure being exerted on your back.



5. To get off safely, lift yourself up back to crawling position then kneeling position or repeat step 3 follow by step 2.



6. Uses include: air mattress, relaxation, sunbathing, massage, relieving pelvic pains, floating around in the pool and whatever else you would like to do on your stomach!

## INFLATION:

Your Saridjo™ product is equipped with the following valve:



**Safety Valve** – push-in valve used on safety chambers for use with electric or hand pump. Affix the end of your inflator hose into the small opening in valve. Make sure you open the small flap inside the opening and inflate until firm. A small plastic straw is included with tubes using this valve. This straw may temporarily be inserted in the valve to keep the flap open while inflating and deflating.

Proper inflation is the key to the optimum performance of this product. The PVC pool lounge must expand and should be firm to the touch.

Secure the valve by firmly fastening the bottom portion of the valve into the base. To inflate, open cap or top portion of the valve. Using the hose from your inflator, inflate through the top opening of the valve.

Proper inflation is the key to the optimum performance of this pool lounge and there should be very few wrinkles when the float is properly inflated. The best air pumps to use are:

- 110v electric
- Hand/foot pump designed for inflatables.

## Inflation Maintenance:

Finally, it is not enough to simply fill it up and go! It is important to monitor the amount of air in this product as heat will cause the float to expand, possibly causing damage to the seams or I-beams. If you leave a full tube sitting in the sun for any length of time, it will expand. Either store it in the shade, or let some air out. Don't let it sit outdoor full of air! At the same time, if it is stored out of the sun in a cool place, you may need to add air. Check and adjust inflation levels each time you use your tube. You'll have more fun, and your products will last longer.

## MAINTENANCE:

Very little care is required for the product components:

- You may clean your product using soap and water or mild detergent.
- Never use strong cleaning agents.
- The product, when clean and dry, can be deflated and stored in a cool, dry area out of direct sunlight.
- To deflate, simply unfasten the valve from the base and poke a drinking straw to the hole will hold the valve open and let the air out faster.
- Avoid storing this product in areas of extreme temperatures and please take precautions against animals and rodents.

## GENERAL TROUBLE SHOOTING GUIDE:

**Symptom:** Product won't hold air.

**Solution:** Check to see that the valve is fastened or screwed on properly. Re-install valve if needed. Check to see if the product was inflated fully from the beginning.

**Symptom:** Product is fully inflated but feel wobbly to get on it.

**Solution:** Always have someone to assist you to get on and off safely the pool lounge, especially when you are pregnant.

**Symptom:** Have doubts about using the product.

**Solution:** Stop using the float immediately if you have any doubt about using this pool lounge before or after this product is inflated or deflated.

**Symptom:** Product inflates but doesn't become firm.

**Solution:** Please check to make sure it was inflated firmly with a high volume air pump. If you are sure you inflated it properly, examine it for a leak or re-install the valve. If a leak is detected, you may return or exchange the product to the store where you purchased.
