| <p>Tasting Note from Wine Align – Steve Thurlow (87 points): This wine is from Nemea in the Peloponnese where the red wines are made from Agiorgitiko, (A-YOR-YI-TI-CO) probably Greece's best indigenous red grape. It is excellent value for a soft food friendly red not unlike Chianti or barbera from Italy. Expect aromas of red berry fruit with mild spice and floral notes. The palate has soft fruit balanced by dry tannin and gentle acidity. Very good length. It is an ideal food wine for a wide range of meats and cheeses. Best 2014 to 2017.
