

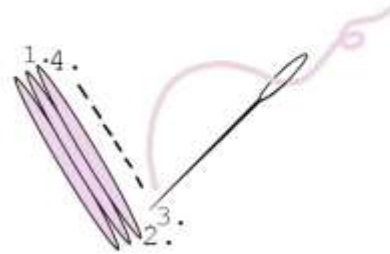
# Stitch Guide

## Back Stitch



Back stitch starts at 1 and brought back down at 2. You then leave a space and come up at 3 and back down at 2.

## Satin Stitch



Bring the needle up through the fabric at 1 and down at 2. Then bring the needle back up right next to 2, this spot is 3 and over to 4. The thread should lay flat and be stitched close together with no gaps.

## French Knot



Bring the needle up through the fabric and hold the bottom of the thread tightly. Wrap the needle around the thread while holding it tight then place the needle back down through the same hole. This will create the knot at the surface of the fabric. The tighter you hold the fabric, the more secure the knot is.

## Straight Stitch



Bring the needle up through the fabric and then back down in a straight direction. This is a fun stitch and can be done in any size desired. Each stitch is a single stitch, none of them are connected.
