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NOTICE SEEKING POSSESSION OF A PROPERTY LET ON AN ASSURED SHORTHOLD TENANCY

This notice is the first step towards requiring you to give possession of your home. You should read it very carefully.

If you need to find out about this Notice and what you should do about it, take it as quickly as possible to any of the following:

A Citizens Advice Bureau. A Housing Aid Centre. A Law Centre. Or a Solicitor.

You may be able to get Public Funding, but this will depend on your personal circumstances.

If the period of your tenancy has come to an end your Landlord cannot use this Notice but must serve you with a Section 21 Notice.

If you are willing to give up possession of your home without a court order, you should tell the person who signed this Notice as soon as possible and say when you can leave.
