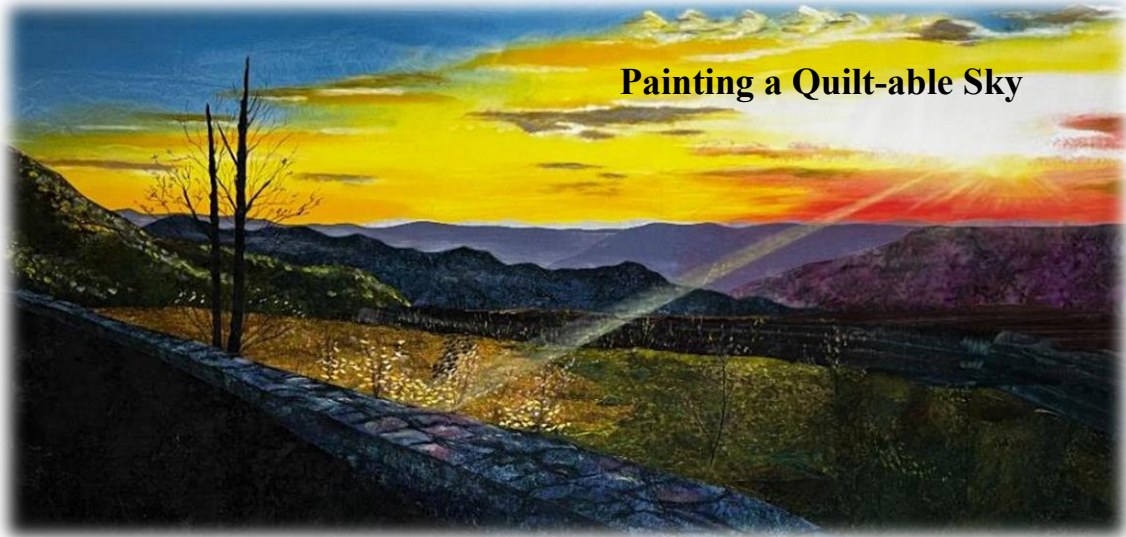

Painting a Quilt-able Sky

39 x 76"

Materials:

- Inspiration photo
- PFD Fabric - 4 Fat Quarters
- Acrylic Paints – Artistic Artifacts Fluid, Semi-Transparent Textile Paints
- Artistic Artifacts opaque paints (*optional*, your choice of colors)

Semi-Transparent colors needed: FYI, these are the fluid paints sold in 4 & 8 oz. bottles

Opaque paints are at your discretion. You may or may not need them. It depends on how dramatic your sky is.

- Painters' Brushes – various sizes: 1 inch, 2 inch and 3 inch (no sponge brushes)
- Fine Art Brushes – various sizes for detail work
- Empty yogurt containers for mixing paints and rinsing brushes
- Spray bottle
- Paper towels
- Hair dryer
- Plastic drop cloth to cover table
- Painter's tape
