Blue Onion Quilt with Dudley Shugart

Learn the technique to make this "swirling" one-block quilt, including instructions on precise curved piecing. As noted in the class description, due to the complexity of this curved block students will not finish their quilt top, but you will leave class with all the skills necessary to complete your Blue Onion quilt at home!

Student Supply List

Please bring the following with you to class:

- [Oval All Ways Creative Grids Quilt Ruler](#)
- Fabric for the blocks: 3/8 yard each of at least 12 different contrasting fabrics
 - If you desire a scrappy quilt, you will need 36 fabrics 12.5 in. x 14 in.
 - More fabric will be required if you desire to make your quilt larger than 50 in. x 70 in.
- Sewing machine in good working order with 1/4 inch or straight stitch foot
 - Remember to bring your manual, power cord, foot pedal and all necessary accessories
- 28 mm rotary cutter (smallest one), cutter mat
- basic sewing notions: thread, pins, scissors, etc.

BLUE ONION

Finished Quilt: 50" x 70"

The Blue Onion swirling blocks are made from a variety of contrasting prints. To change it up – make them out of any 12 contrasting prints that you like. The arcs are long and gentle which makes them easy to sew. Work with 6 different prints at a time to make one set of blocks. This makes it easy to make more, just add to the mix in sets of 6 additional rectangles for 6 additional blocks. Or, take a practice run with 6 rectangles and turn it into a table runner! Enjoy!

Fabric Requirements

For Blocks

3/8 yard each of 6 different dark gray/black value prints
3/8 yard each of 6 different medium value green/brown prints
Or 12 different contrasting prints

Binding: 5/8 yard

Backing: 3 1/2 yards

Suggested Ruler:

Ovals Always CGRKA OVAL by Creative Grids

Instructions are included for cutting WITH or WITHOUT the Ovals Always Ruler; however, using the ruler will provide the perfect cut every time.
