May BERNINA Embroidery Skill Building

Monogramming & Lettering Student Supply List:

- Sewing machine and embroidery module, along with basic sewing supplies, including small scissors
- <u>BERNINA Large Oval embroidery hoop</u>, or hoop approximately 5.7-inches x 10-inches
- You will need to <u>OESD "Essential Monograms" design pack</u> <u>#12719</u> and load it onto a USB stick to use during class
- Bobbin wound with lightweight thread, such as <u>DecoBob 80</u> weight polyester thread, available at Artistic Artifacts
- 40wt embroidery thread in a color that will show up on your practice fabric
- 50wt sewing thread in a color that will show up on your practice fabric



- Scrap fabrics, such as muslin, that are large enough to fit into your BERNINA Large Oval embroidery hoop to practice your monogram designs. We will have time to experiment with several different designs.
 - Optional: one item to monogram in class, such as a dishtowel or napkin. Bring a wash-away stabilizer, such as OESD <u>Aquamesh WashAway</u>, available at Artistic Artifacts, if you don't want any stabilizer to show on the back of your item
 - If you bring a towel with nap ("loopy" terrycloth) you will need to bring a "topper" stabilizer, such as OESD <u>StitcH2O WashAway</u>, available at Artistic Artifacts
- Heavyweight stabilizer, such as OESD <u>Heavy Weight CutAway</u>, available at Artistic Artifacts. Bring enough stabilizer to hoop several projects
- Adhesive tape such as OESD Tear Away Tape. You might have received this with your embroidery module; it is also available at Artistic Artifacts
- <u>Temporary fabric marking tool</u> such as a wash-away pen
