50 Task 1

The correct answers are:

- Donna and Dietmar - **Connected**
- Local residents - ~~Internal~~
- Members of the management committee - ~~Connected~~
- The four building companies - ~~External~~

Donna and Dietmar are connected stakeholders as they are trustees of the charity.

The management committee are **internal** to the charity as they can legally bind the charity.

The building companies are in negotiation with the management committee and therefore are **connected** stakeholders.

Local residents will always be **external** stakeholders.

The explanation of the answer is correct. Local residents are external stakeholders, members of the management committee are internal stakeholders and the four building companies are connected stakeholders.
