Amendments to the syllabus

No syllabus amendments as such, but the formula tables have been amended to remove normal distribution tables. This means that questions on 'value at risk' will have to give the information that would be previously have been provided in the normal distribution table within the question itself.

The formula table has also been amended to remove the formulae for calculating the values for N(d1) and N(d2) in the Black-Scholes model, but this will not have an impact in the exam as the Black-Scholes model calculations are now automated by the use of a spreadsheet that is provided.

Syllabus changes

The main syllabus for AFM remains unchanged.
