


Sinus Relief


Nasal Polyps


Polypoidal masses are also known commonly as nasal polyps. These are small benign growths that you will see around the nose edge and are quite uncomfortable for many people. They can vary in different sizes and cause inflammation of the sinuses. They are normally described as jelly like, grape shaped extra growths on the nose edges that have a grey, yellow or pink hue to it.
