Non Toxic Surfactant

Paradise Nutrients conditioning shampoo contains non toxic surfactants from plant based ingredients.

There are many benefits to using plant based raw materials in horse shampoos. The environmental impact from plant based surfactants are very low and their use is an advantage in the reduction of strong chemicals.

Traditionally, propylene glycol (the first cousin of a surfactant) is derived from petroleum, a non renewable source and somewhat unfriendly foaming agent.

Over recent years plant based surfactants have been discovered from renewable plant based compounds with much more friendly compounds.

These new plant based surfactants form a lather in water that acts as an effective cleansing agent but are gentle and safe for our horses and their owners with the added benefits of being kind to our environment.



Melaleuca Alternifolia

There are around 140 compounds that make up the extracts from this amazing tree. Traditionally Melaleuca Alternifolia has been used topographically as a medical aid because of its anti-bacterial, antifungal, antiviral and antimould properties.

Paradise Nutrients not only includes Tea tree extracts from the whole plant, but also the Tea tree. So along with its amazing cleansing benefits, it also offers many helpful medicinal benefits.

The benefits from Tea tree are numerous as it has been proven to contain certain compounds and minerals that support a healthy immune system. It is thought that many viruses, bacteria, fungus and mould thrive in a horse's living environment, especially in stables. This is where PN Horse Shampoo shines as it has the potential to deter or kill those harmful pathogens that your horse may be exposed to.



Original Quality and Safety

The Tea Tree oil and Melaleuca extracts used in Paradise Nutrients products is from the finest quality Tea Tree oil found anywhere in the world. Our oil is a genuine product, free from any harmful chemical additives, or synthetics. Grown "As Nature Intended".

Our products comes from an area in Australia where the Mother Trees are still standing. These trees have been tested to be over 1000 years old. The compounds in these trees and their offspring where the oil comes from contains the original DNA which guarantees original quality and superior strength of the extracts.

It is also well documented that Tea Tree oil contains some volatile compounds composed of terpene hydrocarbons, mainly mono-terpenes, sesquiterpene and their associated alcohols. Terpenes are volatile, aromatic hydrocarbons and may be considered polymers.

The plant's stimulating and circulation-promoting properties are beneficial to equine and canine musculoskeletal systems and helps animals with muscle and joint problems to enjoy more mobility and better quality of life.



Chamomile

Chamomile is an excellent essential oil to relieve stress and when applied topically, with a carrier oil, can ease muscle cramps.

Chamomile is known for being a calming, soothing supplement that can have great benefits for horses as well as humans. As a mild relaxant, it is beneficial for horses that get either anxious or excitable and can be used on an ongoing basis or leading up to an event where the animal is likely to feel nervous.

The strong analgesic properties relieve dull muscular aches and stubborn spasms. It will also relieve overworked and inflamed muscles. It is useful for horses when competing in a multiple day event. At the end of each day, Chamomile will help calm the muscles and help the horse relax overnight for the next day.




Ylang Ylang oil

Sourced from the aromatic flowers of the Cananga tree (*Cananga odorata*), ylang ylang essential oil is a natural mood booster and stress reliever. Its soothing properties promote relaxation, reduce anxiety and improve sleep quality. It can also help regulate heart rate and blood pressure, making it a must-add to any shampoo.

Ylang Ylang also has a number of cosmetic applications, where it's been used to reduce hair breakage and moisturises dry and irritated skin. Thanks to its natural antimicrobial properties its sweet aroma also makes it a popular choice for horse owners.

Ylang Ylang Oil reduces anxiety and boosts self esteem when applied to human and animals' skin. Apply Ylang Ylang onto your pulse points (e.g. neck).

Because Ylang Ylang essential oil contains linalool (an ingredient with antibacterial, antifungal and anti-inflammatory properties), it has been shown to be effective at reducing fungal infections.



Coconut Oil

Coconut is a natural ingredient that offers many benefits when used on the coats of horses. Coconut oil is a rich source of fatty acids that can nourish and hydrate the coat, preventing dryness and breakage.

Lauric acid in coconut oil has a low weight and straight structure, which allows coconut oil to easily penetrate the hair shaft. This unique structural quality makes coconut oil great for hair because it can deeply restore hydration, reduce dandruff, repair split ends and prevent hair protein loss.

Coconut oil can also add a natural shine. On its own, coconut oil would not make an effective shampoo as some coconut oil blends can be greasy and messy - which is why we formulated an easy, non greasy coconut oil shampoo for your horse.

Coconut oil also contains vitamin C, vitamin D, iron, calcium, vitamin A, vitamin D, vitamin C, vitamin B1, vitamin B2, vitamin B3, vitamin B5, vitamin B6, vitamin B12, Choline, vitamin K and vitamin E.



Cedarwood Oil

Cedarwood essential oil is a substance derived from the needles, leaves, bark and berries of cedar trees. There are many varieties of cedar trees found around the world. Some trees referred to as cedars are actually juniper trees.
