The Tea tree oil and Melaleuca extracts that are used in PN products come from an area in Australia where the Mother trees are still standing. These trees have been tested to be over 1000 years old. The compounds in these trees and their offspring contain the original DNA which guarantees original quality and superior strength of the extracts.

It is also well documented that Tea tree oil contains some volatile compounds composed of terpene hydrocarbons, mainly monoterpenes, sesquiterpene and their associated alcohols. Terpenes are volatile, aromatic hydrocarbons and may be considered polymers. Paradise Nutrients removes these volatile compounds through a special process without affecting the quality of the active ingredients.

Many Tea tree oils are from GMO Tea tree seedlings, which when tested contain higher levels of the hydrocarbons than the oil that comes from our original Mother tree seedlings.



### Eucalyptus oil

The Australian aborigines used Eucalyptus leaves to treat wounds and prevent infection as well as repelling mosquitoes and other biting insects that can carry diseases. Avoiding their bites is our best defence. The compounds from Eucalyptus are an effective natural insect repellent for your pet.

The insect repellent activity of Eucalyptus oils has been due to the components such as 1,8-cineole, citronellal, citronellol, citronellyl acetate, p-cymene, eucamalol, limonene, linalool,  $\alpha$ -pinene,  $\gamma$ -terpinene and  $\alpha$ -terpineol.

Antifungal components in Eucalyptus oil is an excellent ingredient for pets as it helps to repel flies and insects as well as combats the yeast-like fungus, Malassezia, the most common cause of flaky skin and dandruff. Its anti-inflammatory and pain-relieving properties, coupled with its natural cooling sensation, makes Eucalyptus ideal for soothing sun damaged skin. Its antibacterial properties also protect the skin from infection.



### Aloe Vera is high in Vitamins & Minerals:

Aloe Vera is the most ideal natural ingredient for moisturising skin. It contains humectants - substances that attract water from the air or from deeper inside the skin - it's thought to be especially beneficial for dry skin types. Aloe Vera specifically contains mucopolysaccharides, which binds moisture into the skin. It also has cohesive effects by sticking together flaking epidermal skin cells, resulting in softer skin and improved skin integrity.
