


Create a Vlog


What is needed to create a successful vlog? Watch the video and draw up your own success criteria.





Your vlog's layout:

Set out roughly what you want to include in the different parts of your vlog - you can create a script if you feel the need. You will plan one part and then film straight away before going on to the next part.


Part 1: Your response to the two big questions. Explain what the questions were and look back at the post-it.



Part 2: Your reaction (on video!) to the film. What makes 'react-to' videos fun and funny?



Part 3: Go back to the two big questions and answer them again. Have your views changed? How? And why?



Don't forget to edit the vlog to make it exciting and to encourage people to continue watching!
