

DIRECTIONS

From the Mid-Cape Highway (Rte. 6): Take exit 59 and turn left onto Rte. 130 until you enter Sandwich Village. Bear left after Main Street turn, Museum is on the right opposite the Old Town Hall. Entrance and parking on Tupper Road. Beyond Cape Cod:

From the Sagamore Bridge take Route 6A east to Route 130 (turn right) - Continue on 130 for about 3 miles. Museum is on the left at the corner of 130 and Tupper Road.
