SORBY ADAMS THE THING 2018 BAROSSA SHIRAZ

The Thing is our flagship Shiraz at Sorby Adams. Sourced from fruit grown in low yielding hand pruned Barossa Shiraz vineyards dating back to the 1930s, these vines are some of the oldest in the region.

Only our best barrels make their way into this classic Shiraz showing why the old-vine fruit of the Barossa and Eden Valleys' is so highly sought after. Spending 40 months on fine grained French oak, it has provided sophisticated structure and tannins whilst retaining the fruit complexity and richness.

WINEMAKERS NOTES:

Colour - Deep inky magenta with a purple hue.

Aroma - This is magnificently fruited and gloriously expressed on the nose showing blackberry, spiced plum, chocolate tart, cake spice and cedar characters.
Palate - A sumptuous palate that is opulent and impressively weighted. The wine is powerfully graceful with a seamless flow to an impressively long engaging finish.

Cellar - At its best: now to 2038.

Fruit - Shiraz - sourced from Eden Valley and Barossa Valley, Barossa.
