## WINEMAKERS NOTES:

Colour - Deep cherry red with plum purple hue.

Aroma – Blackberry and ripe raspberry with star anise and cashew characters on the nose.

Palate - Gratifying with succulent blackberry fruits with a full mouthfeel and excellent depth of flavour. Richness and velvety smooth tannins lead to a persistent finish.

Cellar - At its best: now to 2028. Fruit - Shiraz sourced from the Barossa
