SORBY ADAMS THE REVEREND CANON 2018 BAROSSA SHIRAZ

Family is important to us and this wine is named after my great uncle, The Reverend Canon R.K. Sorby-Adams, OBE. He was Headmaster and Minister at St Andrew's School in Singapore from 1928 to 1956 and the Minister at St Hugh's Anglican Church in my home town of Angaston from 1957 to 1960. This classic Barossa Shiraz display quintessential character and regional typicity.

WINEMAKERS NOTES:

Colour - Deep red with magenta hue.

Aroma - Classic Barossa Shiraz blackcurrant and cedar.

Palate - Ripe blackcurrant, rich cocoa and cedar weave seamlessly with finely textured tannin, combining generous fruit weight with savoury notes.

Cellar - At its best: now to 2035.

'The Reverend Canon' Barossa Shiraz 2018 (\$75) – Deep maroon colour here. Bold flavours to the fore, there is an almost explosive nose, with flavours and aromas just pouring out. Shows just what a couple of years in the cellar can do for a good Barossa Shiraz from a top vintage – and 2018 is certainly that. This is a cracker. Notes of black fruits, cassis, molten chocolate, dark and rich coffee beans, tobacco leaves, leather and licorice. Just such a gorgeous palate, so seductive. Silly tannins, impressive length and balance. This has a good ten to fifteen years ahead of it. Love it.
