

Family is important to us and this wine is named after my great uncle, The Reverand Canon R.K. Sorby-Adams, OBE. He was Headmaster and Minister at St Andrew's School in Singapore from 1928 to 1956 and the Minister at St Hugh's Anglican Church in my home town of Angaston from 1957 to 1960.

This classic Barossa Shiraz display quintessential character and regional typicity.

WINEMAKERS NOTES:

Colour - Deep ruby red with purple hue.

Aroma - Typical Barossa Shiraz chocolate, blackberry and cedar.

Palate - Plush blackberry, dark chocolate and toasted spice weave seamlessly with finely textured tannin, combining generous fruit weight with savoury notes.

Cellar - At its best: now to 2035.
