

## RING SIZE GUIDE

### HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

Whether you are looking for a ring for your ring finger or any other finger or position on your hand, we would like to give you some advice on hand, thus the ring you are ordering will fit you properly for the intended finger.

### RING FINGER MEASURING TIPS

Make sure your finger is at a normal body temperature. Fingers can shrink or expand when cold or hot. If your knuckle is much larger than your finger's base, take two separate measurements and choose a size in between. You want a ring to fit over your knuckle, but not be too loose or it will shift around.

Please note for your order that NIVES uses European sizing, the number in grey corresponds to the specific size and the letter is the NIVES size.

There are different ways to find out which ring size you will need.

### OPTION 1

#### MEASURE CURRENT RING

STEP 1: Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger. Engagement and wedding rings are traditionally worn on the ring finger on the left hand in the United States.

STEP 2: Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring.

STEP 3: If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.

## MAKE SURE THE GUIDE HAS THE RIGHT MEASUREMENTS



- Please, measure the bar at the left to make sure your print out is correctly sized.
- If the bar does not measure exactly 3 cm, check that page scaling is set to "none" on your print out dialog box, and that you are printing at full size.



The letters on the Sizes are only for NIVES size references. They are not the UK size measurements, which are also referred to in letters.

This is for reference only. NIVES cannot be held responsible for any errors that occur as a result of measuring your finger.

## OPTION 2

### MEASURING YOUR FINGER

Your ring should fit your finger comfortably. It should be tight enough so that it will not fall off, but loose enough to slide over your knuckle.

Finger size changes depending on the time of day and the weather. For best results measure your finger size:

STEP 1: At the end of the day and when your fingers are warm. (Fingers are smaller in the early morning and when cold).

STEP 2: Measure finger size more than once in order to eliminate an erroneous reading.

STEP 3: Avoid using elastic string or stretchy paper to measure ring size as these materials can stretch or twist, yielding an inaccurate measurement.

### USE THE MEASURING GUIDE TO MEASURE YOUR FINGER

We attached a cut out measuring guide in order to make it easier for you to select the right ring size.

STEP 1: Cut out the measuring guide attached.

STEP 2: After cutting out the guide, cut a slit on the measuring guide where it indicates "CUT HERE". Insert the pointed end through the opening you have cut at the other end of the measuring guide.

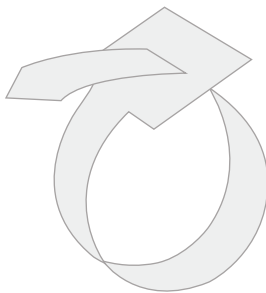
STEP 3: Wrap the size guide around the knuckle (or widest part) of your finger to be sized. Start by placing the flat end of the strip on the finger, and wrap the arrow end around until the fit is tight. Make sure that the numbers are on the outside of the paper.

STEP 4: Once wrapped, the number closest to the arrow point is the ring size. Small marks between the numbers represent half sizes. If in doubt, move up to the next larger half size.

Please note that the NIVES measuring guide is an indicative guide only and therefore may not be an exact measure.

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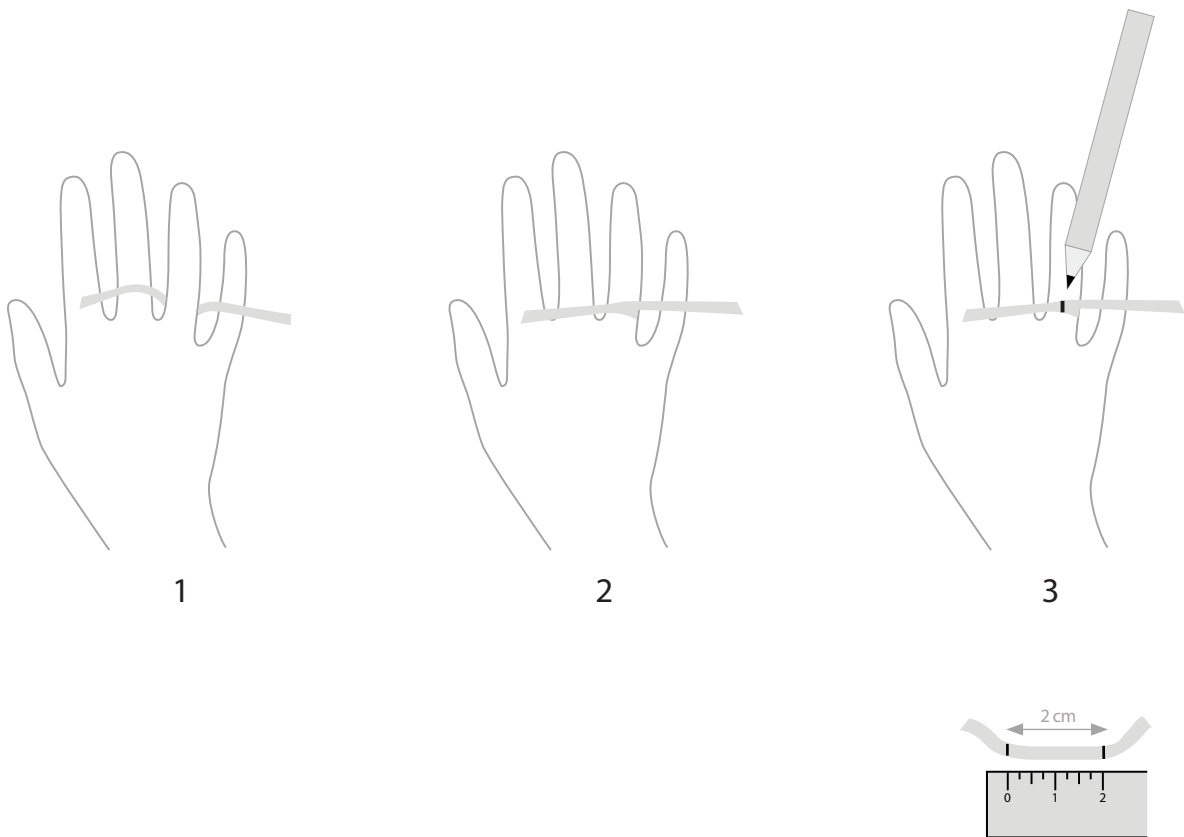
## OPTION 3

### USE A RIBBON

If you have measured the intended finger with a ribbon, or know the circumference in inch or millimeters, use the following chart to convert the length to a ring size.

If in doubt, move up to the next larger half size.

Here again avoid using elastic string to measure ring size as this material can stretch or twist, yielding an inaccurate measurement.



### INTERNATIONAL SIZE CONVERSION

If ordering from outside of Switzerland or Europe, determine your ring size according to your country's standard.

Then use the International Ring Size Chart to convert to the corresponding European ring size to place your order.
